Annual Report of N.S.S. Activity and Special Camp for 2018-2019

N.S.S. Unit of K. B. College of Arts & Commerce for Women had started the academic year 2018-2019 under the guidance of Program Officers Dr. Deepak B Bansod and Dr. V K Raje. An Orientation lecture was organized wherein many interested students willingly came forward and enrolled themselves for the cause of society.

Two projects were undertaken in the adopted area Phanaswadi, Neral, Dist -Raigad i.e.

(i) Health & Hygiene and (ii) AIDS Awareness. These two projects made people aware of health related, consumer related, Aids related and women related problems and their remedies. N.S.S. Unit of the college had selected **HIV/AIDS Awareness** as one of the project for the year 2018-2019 Phanaswadi, Neral, Dist. Raigad was selected as the adopted area for the awareness programme. A survey was conducted by the volunteers in the adopted area before starting the awareness work. As per guidelines given by N.S.S. cell of University of Mumbai a Red Ribbon Club was formed. The Red Ribbon Club Volunteers undertook various awareness activities in adopted area, which created awareness amongst the volunteers, students and society people of adopted area.

Disaster Management: N.S.S. Unit of the college has conducted number of programmes during the academic year 2018-2019. Out of which Disaster Management was one of the most important activity. As per the guidelines given by University N.S.S. Cell, a Disaster Management Cell was formed. Volunteers and N.S.S. members were given basic training of various disaster management techniques and understood the presence of mind required for handling disaster.

Note book preparation & distribution & save electricity project:

In K. B. college of Arts and Commerce, we as a N.S.S. Unit worked on two social welfare project. **Note book Preparation & Distribution:** The first project was related with charity towards mass neglected, deprived section of society. According to our planning, we invited all the students' suggestion for this project. As per our discussion we asked students to tear out some blank pages of their old note book. The bunch of blank pages will turn and manufactured into a new note book, which we decided to donate to school children. The donation of note book was targeted to the students who were in greater need.

The other University level project was on awareness related to **save electricity** among local community. Students were taught with different methods to save electricity. The students reached out to every home of Phanaswadi, Neral, Dist. Raigad and created awareness. In the



result the electricity bill and some positive changes in terms of electricity consumption and bill were noticed.

BLOOD DONATION CAMP 05TH FEBRUARY 2019

K.B. College of Arts and Commerce for Women had organized a Blood Donation Camp on 05th February 2019 in association with Thane Municipal Corporation's Shivaji Hospital, Kalwa. It was organized at College Campus in Kopri, Thane - East from 9.00 am to 2.00 pm. NSS volunteers had done a door to door campaign at Kopri and college for the noble cause. 136 volunteers had participated in the drive. In all total 54 units of Blood was collected in the camp. Many volunteers how could not donate due to various reasons, vowed to do it next time. In all the camp was very successful.

Many more activities like tree-plantation, street play, door to door campaign, Health Check-up Camp, Discipline maintained during Ganpati Festival, rallies on various causes along with celebration of Independence Day, Republic Day, NSS Foundation Day, Teacher's Day, AIDS Awareness Day, etc. were undertaken.

Extension Unit- Annual Report 2018-19

The year 2018-19 commenced with the zestful enrollment of students in Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension, University of Mumbai in July and August 2018. Total 66 students were enrolled for the extension programme. The SWS (Status of Women in Society) project was chosen by the students. The first term training programme was conducted by DLLE at VPM's B.N. Bandodkar College of Science, Thane on 4th August, 2018. The training was very helpful for the faculty and students as well. The first term training programme for the students was conducted in the college on 16th Oct 2018 by designated DLLE field coordinator Dr. Vinda Manjramkar. Madam gave a guidance lecture to the students and solved all their queries satisfactorily. The students carried out survey work in October, November and December 2018. Then on 11th December, 2018, a second term DLLE training was held at Seth Hirachand Mutha College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Adharwadi, Kolivali, Kalyan. The training was based on completion of project reports. Then the field coordinator Dr. Vinda Manjramkar, conducted the second term training session for the students on 13th Jan 2019 in the college itself. In this session, she explained the process of analysis of the data collected, report writing and documentation required for project. On 19th Feb, 2019 at Chandrabhan College, Powai, Udaan festival was held. Which was attended by 13 students and 3 faculty. 12 students participated in the street play based on different social issues such as child marriage; gender discrimination; female foeticides etc. and one student participated in the poster making competition. Then with the distribution of certificates by DLLE Director Dr. Dilip Patil, the festival was ended. The DJ was also arranged for the student. The student had a great learning experience at the annual DLLE festival. The assessment of the student projects was carried out in the month of March 2019 by the faculty and DLLE field coordinator. In all 60 students successfully completed the project. The final assessment of the projects by DLLE was held on 12th April 2019 at Ambedkar B.Ed. College, Vikhroli.

Annual Report- Cultural Activities 2018-19

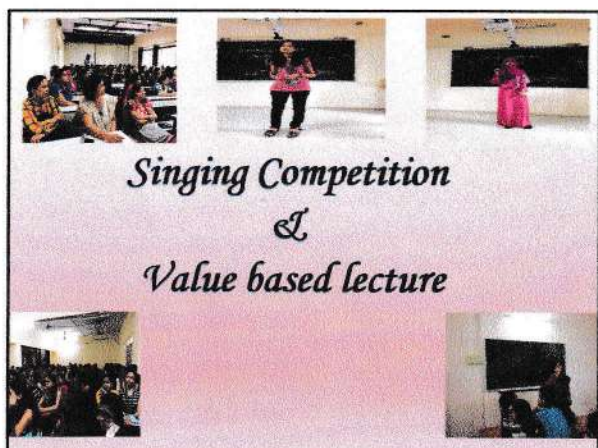
