#### **Annual Report 2018-19**

In this academic year, Commerce & Accounts Department conducted various activities for the benefit of students. All these activities helped in overall development of our students. Following is the summary of all the activities conducted in the year 2018-19:

**1. Add on course – Basics of Capital Market & Technical analysis (20<sup>th</sup> August 2018 to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018)**

Commerce & Accounts Department, K. B. College of Arts & commerce for women, Thane, in collaboration with Machinfini conducted an Add on Course on the topic 'Basics of Capital Market & Technical analysis'. This activity was initiated with the support of College Principal Dr. Renu Trivedi and Mr. Raju Madaswamy, Machinfini. The objective of the course was to train students with practical knowledge in capital market to align with financial inclusion.

In this course 10 students took actively part and completed 30 hours course successfully. The course was the combination of theory as well as practical lecture.

Outcome: Those 10 students learned in detail about the working of Stock exchange and SEBI in the field of capital market.

**2. Investors Awareness Program (7th September 2018)**

As per the directives from MCA, to organize the "Investors awareness Program" at various places in Maharashtra, the Commerce & Accounts Department of K.B College took the initiative and organized a session on 07/09/2018 with resource person, Speaker Dr. Dilip Bhangade who is an approved resource person by SEBI to conduct such program.

Students participated in good number and were very active and participative. The college faculties too were part of the informed audience. PowerPoint presentations were done on investment related factors, risks, avenues, recent malpractices, rights, duties and powers of regulatory bodies.

**Outcome-**The students became aware about basics of investment. They could understand the risk and return calculations. They got information regarding all regulatory bodies to be cautions and safe investors who knows his/her rights and powers.

**3. Industrial Visit to Jawarharlal Nehru Port Trust, Uran (29<sup>th</sup> September 2018)**

The department of Commerce and Accountancy had organized a visit to JNPT on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2018.



### Objectives:

- a. To explore the knowledge in the field of export.
- b. To gain practical knowledge about loading and unloading of Ship arrived at Port.

We got an opportunity to visit JNPT and 45 students of T.Y.B.com along with the department faculty visited JNPT.

### Outcome:

Through this visit T.Y.B.com students came to know working of Port facility. They gained invaluable experience regarding export of Cargo that took place via Ship. Students also witnessed the loading and unloading of the Ship. This has helped them to widen their horizon.

#### 4. Report on One Day Symposium on "Research Methodology and Intellectual Property Rights"

Excelssior Education Society's Commerce and Accountancy Department of K. B. college of Arts & Commerce for Women, Thane had organized One Day Symposium on "Research Methodology And Intellectual Property Rights" dated 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2019. The objective of this workshop was to develop research quality among the students. This will enable the participants to define research problem, formulate objectives and hypothesis, to know the statistical tools and gain knowledge of report writing. Another objective was to create awareness on the significance of IPR amongst the people from various sectors in the country.

In the inaugural session **Principal Dr. Renu Trivedi** focused on the need of research awareness among the students and the importance of IPR especially Copy Right, Patents and Trade mark. **HOD Dr Vinayak Raje** shared his view on the role of Research Methodology in the research activity and about IPR. In the pre-lunch session **Adv. Suyash Pradhan** explained in detail about the copy right, patents and trade mark. Especially he focused on the procedure of obtaining the patent. In the post lunch session **Dr. Gandhi** shared his expertise knowledge in the field of research. He covered various topics such as defining the research problem, formulating the research objectives, hypothesis, testing of hypothesis by using different statistical tools and finally about report writing.

This particular workshop was mainly arranged for M.com students as a part of their syllabus. The students got complete knowledge about the research methodology and IPR.

Valedictory speech was given by Principal **Dr. Renu Trivedi** which was followed by vote of thanks by **Ms. Zeenath Shaikh**.

#### 5. Report on Inter-collegiate Paper Presentation competition on Goods & Service Tax (28<sup>th</sup> February 2019)

Department of Commerce and Accountancy of K.B. college of Arts and Commerce organized Inter-Collegiate Paper Presentation Competition for Students on 28.02.19.





Objectives of event:

The main objective of this competition was to analyze the views of young generation on various issues such as-

- GST-A Global Scenario
- GST – Dual Tax Model
- GSTN
- Supply And GST
- GST Impact On Business

In the beginning of the programme, there was a technical session by CA Gaurav Save, an expert in the field. CA Gaurav Save is B. Com, FCA, CS, DISA(ICAI). He discussed with the students about journey of GST in India since its inception period. Implementation of GST has completed its one year on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018. He also explained GST in Indian Context.

Students were allowed to present papers in group. There were 14 groups who participated in this competition. CA Gaurav Save judged the competition.

The feedback from students on technical session was very encouraging.

Technical session generated interest among the students for further reading about GST.

Students also expressed that due to completion they were motivated to review literature on GST. They further showed their interest to consider GST as one of the career option after graduation.

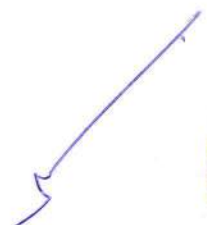

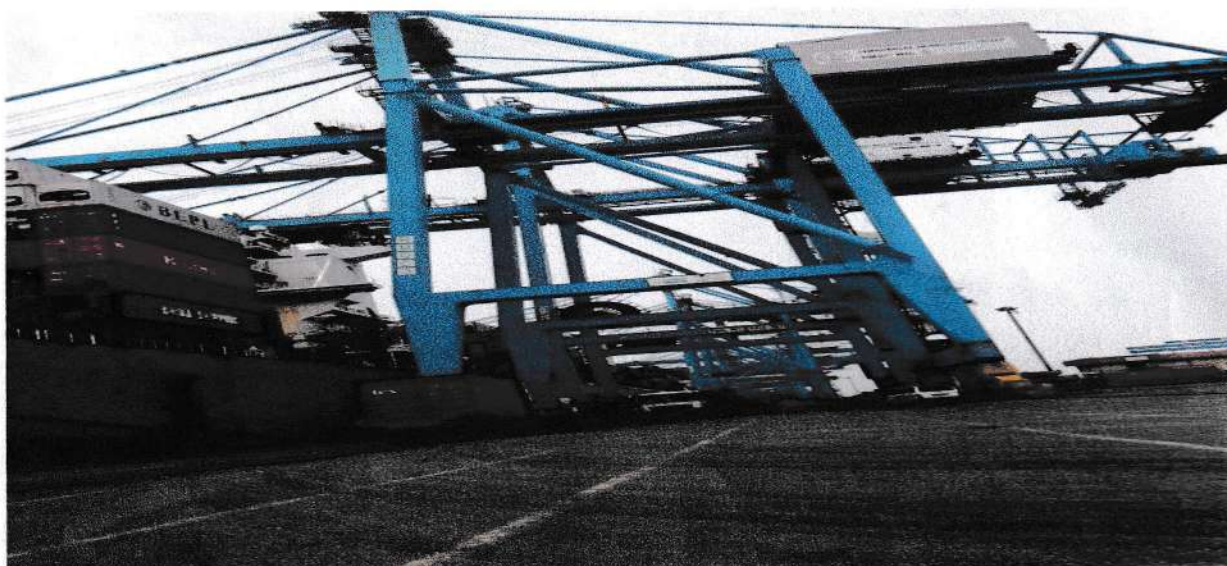

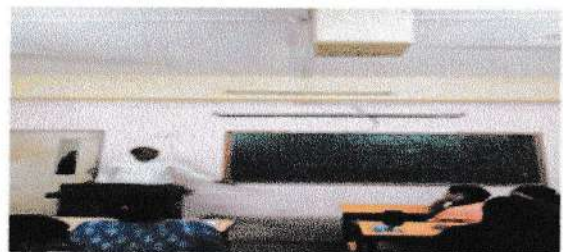

Students actively participated in every activity.



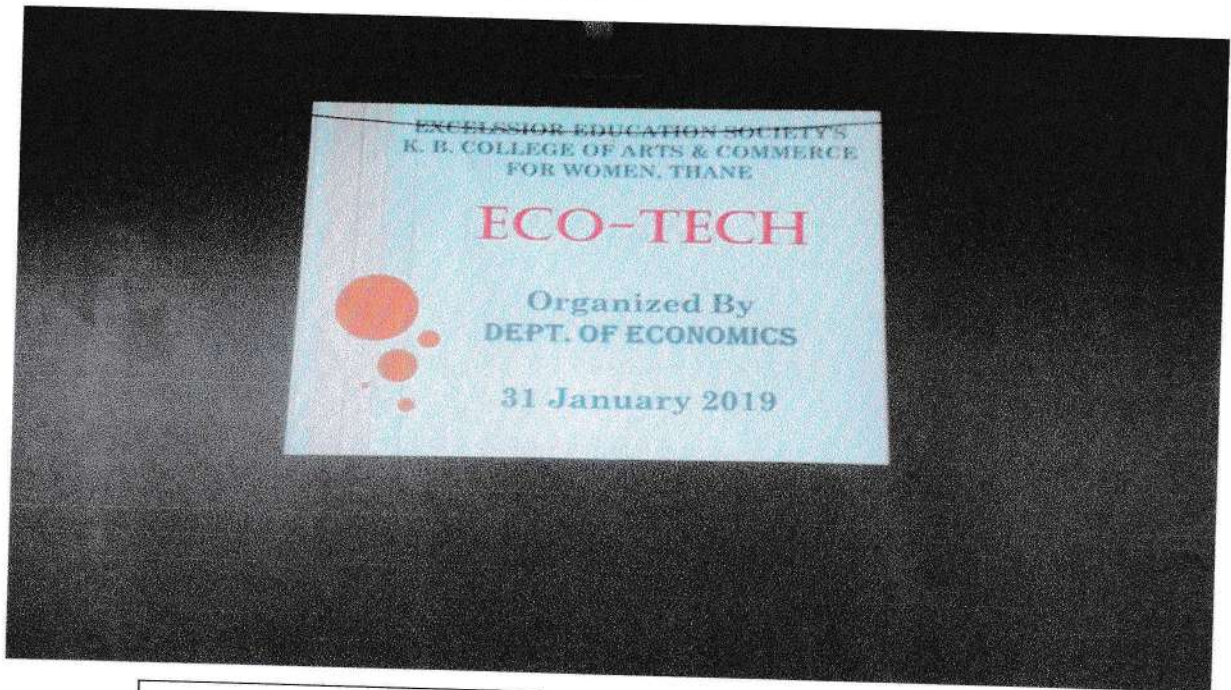

## **Extension Unit- Annual Report 2018-19**


The year 2018-19 commenced with the zestful enrollment of students in Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension, University of Mumbai in July and August 2018. Total 66 students were enrolled for the extension programme. The SWS (Status of Women in Society) project was chosen by the students. The first term training programme was conducted by DLLE at VPM's B.N. Bandodkar College of Science, Thane on 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2018. The training was very helpful for the faculty and students as well. The first term training programme for the students was conducted in the college on 16<sup>th</sup> Oct 2018 by designated DLLE field coordinator Dr. Vinda Manjramkar.
