1. Guest lecture on Carrier Guidance in collaboration with IDOL & CA Institute (1st July, 2019):

K. B. college of Arts and Commerce for women -Department of Commerce and Accountancy in association with Board of studies in Accountancy, University of Mumbai and Western India Regional Council –ICAI organized one day workshop on Goods and Service Tax in K. B. College, campus. The workshop was organized on Monday 01st July 2019.

3. Quiz competition on the occasion of Gandhiji's 150th Birth Anniversary (27th October 2019)

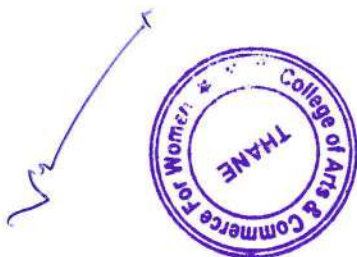

Enriched by experienced and committed faculty, the History Department engages students in diverse activities not only in classrooms but also beyond to hone their analytical and interpretive skills.

'LEGACY' History Association was formed by selecting students for different posts to carry out various activities throughout the academic year 2019-20. As per the tradition of the department, this year also **on July 23 Tilak Jayanti was celebrated** by reading the paper on the life history and the valuable contribution made by the great leader Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak. Students were highly motivated by the inspirational stories of Tilak's life. Independence Day was another occasion that holds great significance in the heart of every Indian citizen. Our students displayed patriotic spirit and love for their country by presenting songs, dances, speeches and poems. An **Independence Day celebration** always adds liveliness and passion in the audience. This day also reminds us of the sacrifice of our great leaders and freedom fighters and makes us more proud of being Indians.

On September 17, the department organised a **career guidance session** for its students by inviting Dr. Pradeep Waghmare as a resource person from Ram Narain Ruia college. More than 100 students attended the session. He guided the students by presenting various choices and opportunities available for the students after graduation with major in History. He also motivated the students for higher education and research in the field.

2nd October was the day to celebrate the **150th birth anniversary of father of our nation, Mahatma Gandhi**. The department encouraged students to celebrate the day by organising PowerPoint presentation competition on the life and ideologies of Gandhi ji. The students made beautiful slides and gave group presentation on the theme. A quiz competition was also organised on this occasion by the department wherein the students from other departments also participated and won the prizes. Beautiful posters were made by the students depicting the values and principles imparted by Gandhiji.

The department focuses on research and innovation by orienting students and faculty to engage in research on new themes and newer ways of doing history. The department always encourages the students to preserve and follow the rich culture and heritage of our nation. Students of the department participated enthusiastically and won prizes in the cultural and traditional days of college organised by the students' council on December 06. **A workshop was also organised on Cultural Heritage and Tourism** on February 15 for the students. Miss Sneha Nagarkar from the University of Mumbai was invited to conduct the workshop and provide guidance to the students. The workshop was very fruitful as it opened a new avenue for the student as a future career options for them.

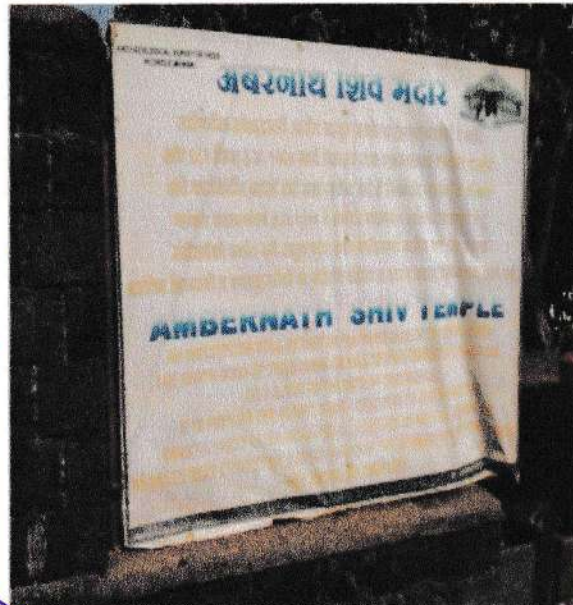
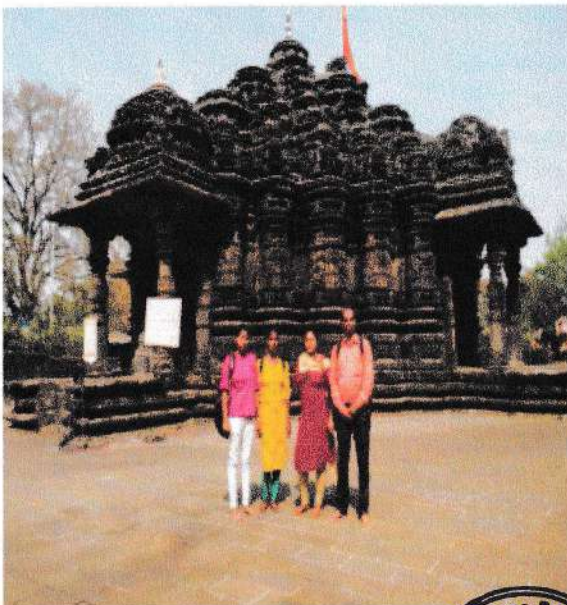

Annual Report 2019-20

The Department of Economics has always been very active in conducting innovative activities which helps students to upgrade their knowledge and explore new dimension of subject.

In the academic year 2019-20, Department of Economics with its full fledged idea for the benefits and upliftment of students started the first activity in the month of July named **REVIEW ON UNION BUDGET**. As a part of curriculum and syllabus, students were asked to prepare presentation on Union Budget. All the students presented a paper on the union budget which threw light on Government financial strategy in all aspects such as Agriculture, Transport, Education, Healthcare system as well as women's progress too. This helped students to understand categorisation of expenditure and revenue collection.

The students of T.Y.B.A(Economics) attended guidance **LECTURE ON UNION BUDGET** Organised by M.C.C College on 9th July 2019. The lecture was delivered by Mr. Santosh who enlightened the information of developmental investment on ISRO, investment on research and development, investment in defence ministry.

The department organised an **EXPERT LECTURE ON FINANCIAL INCLUSION** on 29th August 2019. The lecture was delivered by Mr. Santosh Padi, India Post Payment Bank, Government of India undertaking. The lecture covered various aspects of financial inclusion. Speaker spoke about the history of financial inclusion in India, need, importance and challenges related to financial inclusion. He spoke about the various initiative taken by the government to spread the awareness among the people. As financial inclusion is a part of syllabus, this lecture gave insight to students about the topic. PowerPoint presentation made it more interesting and easier to understand for the students.

This year department added one more feather in its cap by conducting **A.D Shroff Memorial Elocution Competition on 18th September 2019**, the initiative taken by A.D Shroff memorial trust and the Department of Economics which has made a great impact in the minds of the students by giving them the opportunity to think and boldly present their point of view about the economic problems that our country faces today. The winners were given cash prizes and other five participants were given the best speaker certificate.

The Department organized a "**PAPER PRESENTATION ON GANDHIAN ECONOMIC THOUGHT**", on 24 September 2019 on the eve of 150th Birth Anniversary of the Father of Our Nation - Mahatma Gandhi. Students spoke about the Gandhiji's views, Economic Laws, Non-Violent Economy, Decentralisation: Cottage Industries, Khadi Industry, Use of Machines, Regeneration of Villages or Village Sarvodaya, The Trusteeship Doctrine, Law of Bread Labour, Food Problem, Population etc. By the end of the presentation, students



were aware that Gandhiji's basic principle was "plain living " which helps in cutting down your wants which is the beginning of economics and being self-reliant.

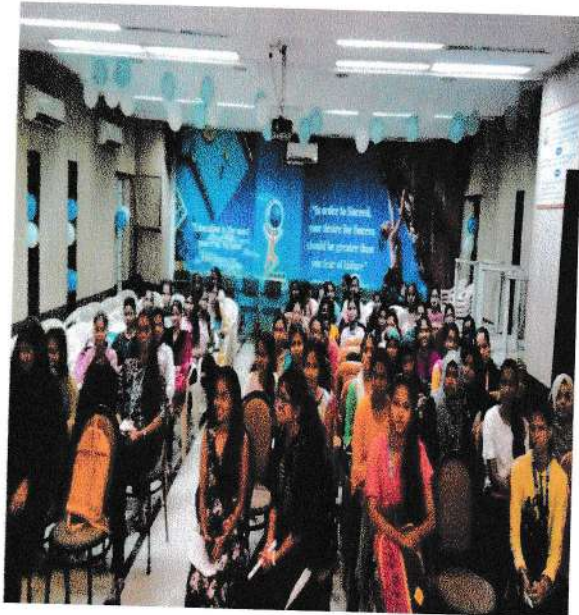
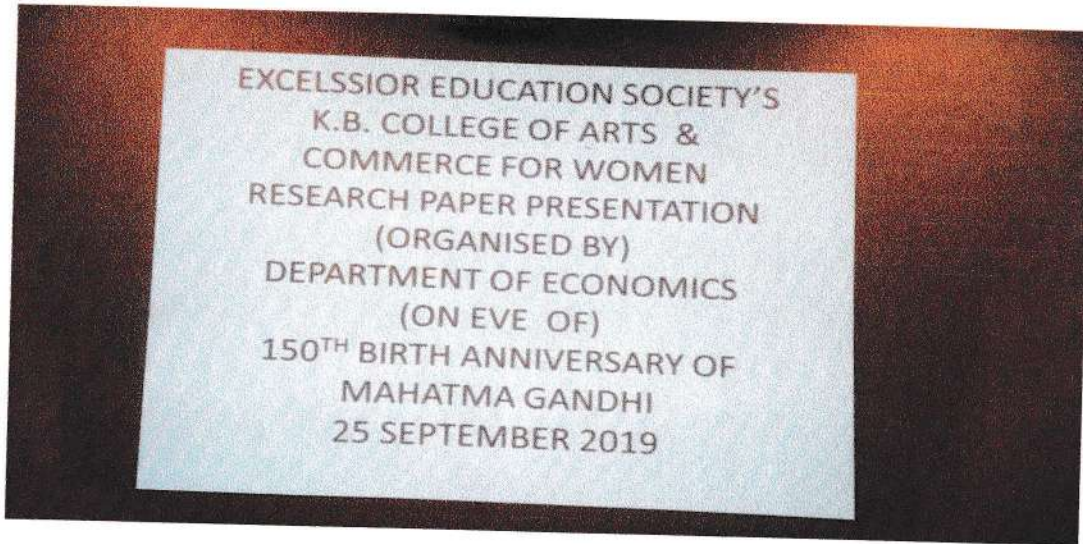

Annual Report: 2019-20

The activities of the Department of Mathematics, Statistics & Computers were organized with an intention of curriculum enrichment. The academic year began with Orientation and Induction for TY, SY and FY students on 6th June, 7th June and 28th June 2019 respectively.

Quantitative Training: One agenda of the department is to guide students for competitive exams. As such, quantitative training was given to 20 students of TYBCom and TYBMS who were undergoing TCS training from 7th June 2019 to 20th June 2019. Out of the 20 students appearing for the recruitment test, 16 cleared the test and were recruited by TCS.

Bridge Course: For the first year BCom students, bridge Course in Mathematics and Statistics was successfully conducted from 9th July 2019 to 15th July 2019. 57 students took benefit of the course. Further, practice class tests were arranged for all students in July'19 and August'19 to prepare them for the semester-end examination.

Gandhi Jayanti Celebration: The entire nation celebrated the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi on 2nd October 2019. The department participated in the celebration by organizing the two activities- a Poster presentation competition on the theme 'Life Sketch of Mahatma Gandhi' and a Film show on Mahatma Gandhi on 26th September 2019. 17 students took part in the poster presentation.

Student Seminars: To enrich the curriculum, the department organized student seminars for TYBCom on 18th November 2019 with 84 participants and a seminar for SYBCom on 23rd December 2019 with 39 participants. Students gave presentations on varied topics related to the world of computers. Their efforts were appreciated by all. For the FYBCom students, seminar on 'Application of Mathematics and Statistics' was organized on 20th February 2020. 15 participants gave beautiful presentations on various applications of the subject in different fields.

Apart from these activities, conducting remedial lectures and taking class tests for examination preparation were routine activities carried out by the department.

Intercollegiate Quantitative Reasoning and Numerical Aptitude test: In March 2020, the entire world faced the threat of covid-19 which was soon declared as a pandemic. The activities of the department continued online in these trying times.



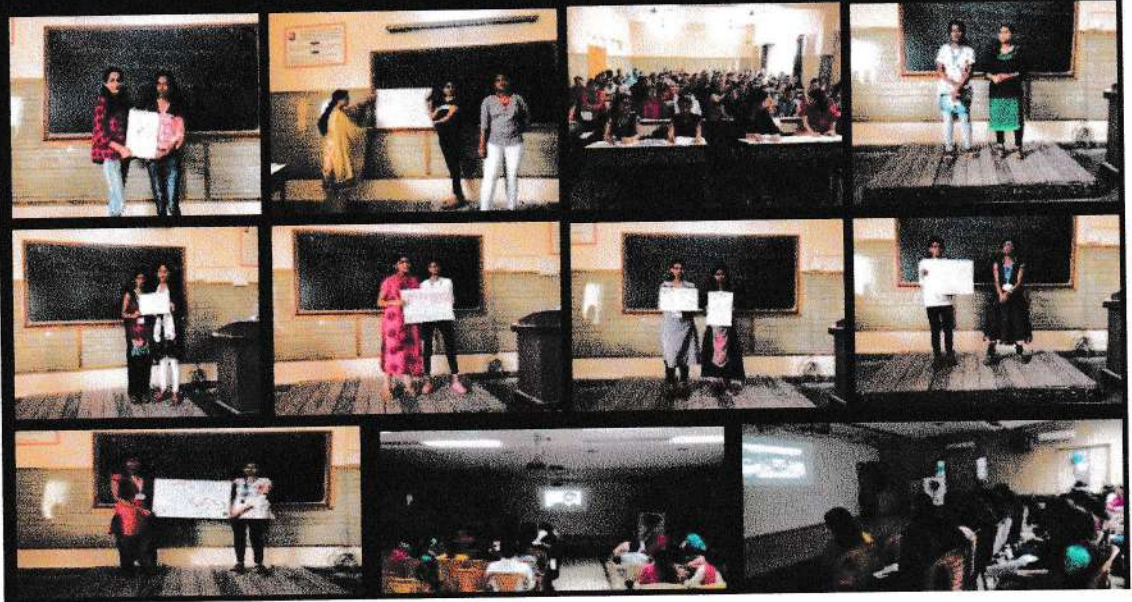

The activities of the department helped in preparing students academically as well as exposing them to different aspects and applications of Mathematics, Statistics and Computers.

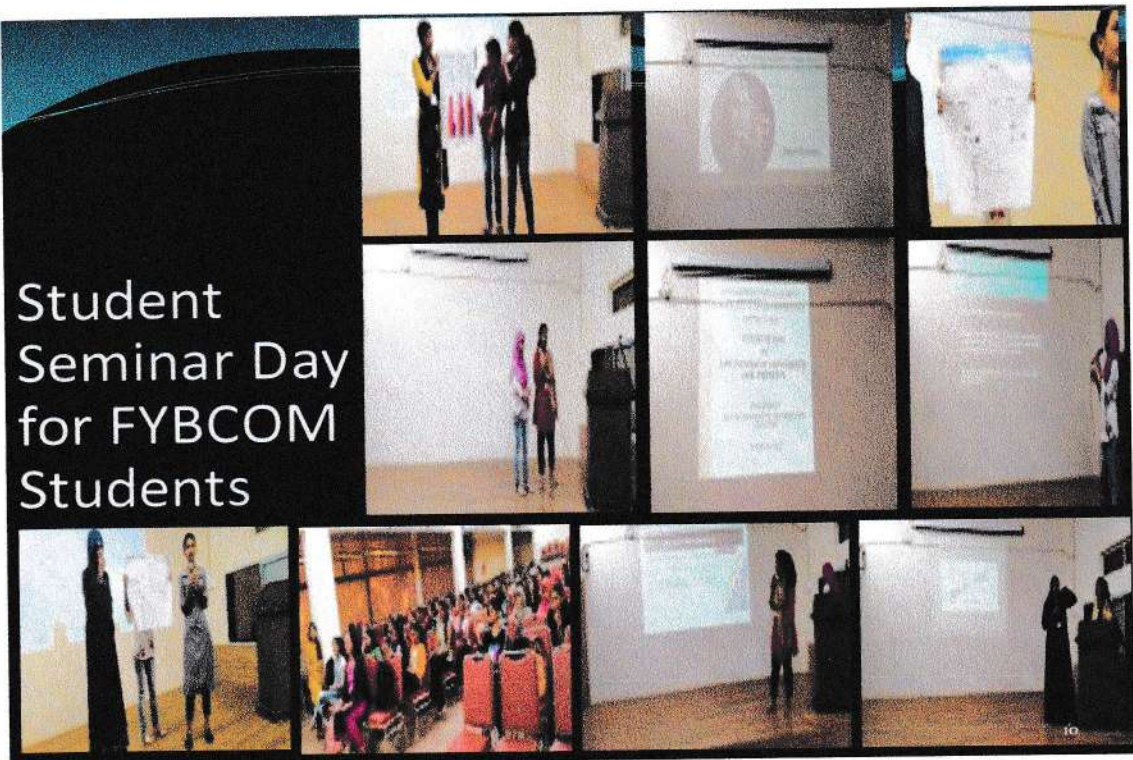


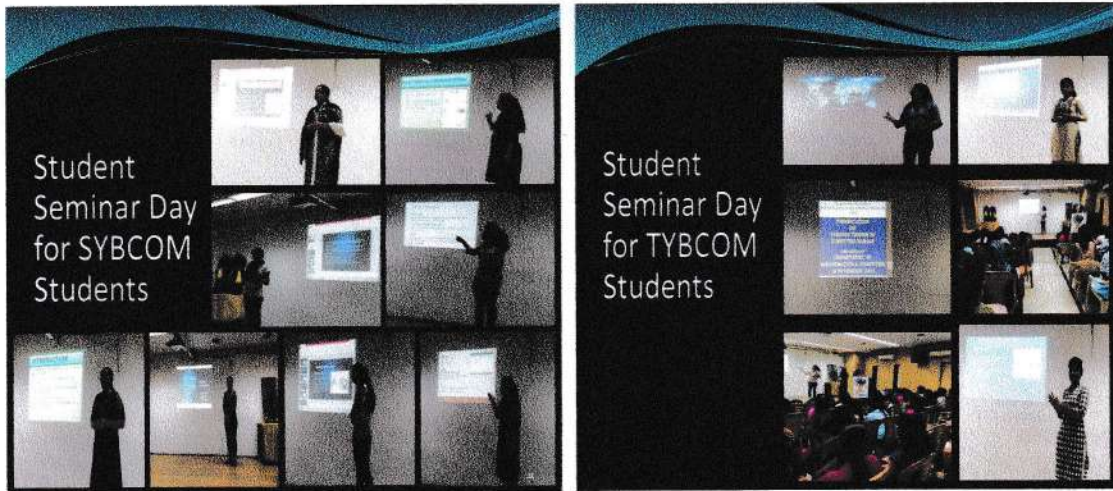

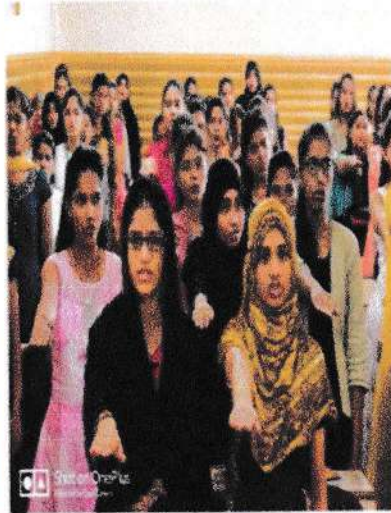

Extension Unit- Annual Report 2019-20

The activities for the year 2019-20 commenced with the enrollment process with Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension, University of Mumbai in July and August 2019. In all, 76 students enrolled for the extension programme and selected three projects i.e., SWS (Status of Women in Society), Career Planning and Annapurna. The first term training programme for the students was conducted in college on 29th August, 2019 by designated DLLE field coordinator Dr. Vinda Manjramkar. She gave a guidance lecture to students and answered all the students' queries satisfactorily. The students carried out survey work in October, November and December 2019. A variety of food stalls like Bhel, Idli, Juices, Tea, Poha, Manchurian, Pani Puri, etc were kept throughout the year under Annapurna Project. The Annapurna Project helped to inculcate entrepreneurship skill among the students.

The second term DLLE training was held on 20th Dec, 2019 at SICES Degree College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Jambhul Phata, Chikholi, Ambarnath. The training was based on completion of project reports. The second term training session for the students by field coordinator Dr. Vinda Manjramkar was held on 4th Jan 2020 in the college. In this session, she explained the process of analysis of the data collected, report writing and documentation required for project. The Udaan festival was held on 31st Jan, 2020 at Shri Sidh Thakurnath College of Arts and Commerce, Ulhasnagar. Total 13 students and 2 faculty attended the festival. Twelve students participated in the street play based on Education System and one student took part in poster making competition. Then the festival was ended with the certificates distribution by DLLE Director Dr. Dilip Patil and was followed by DJ for the student. The students had a great learning experience at the annual DLLE festival. The assessment of the student projects was supposed to carry out in the month of March 2020, but due to Covid-19 pandemic, the evaluation was done on online mode, after a proper evaluation and screening, the reports were submitted to DLLE department. In all 75 students successfully completed the project.

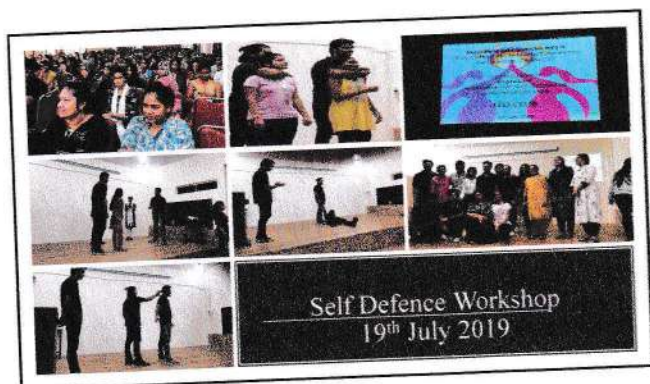

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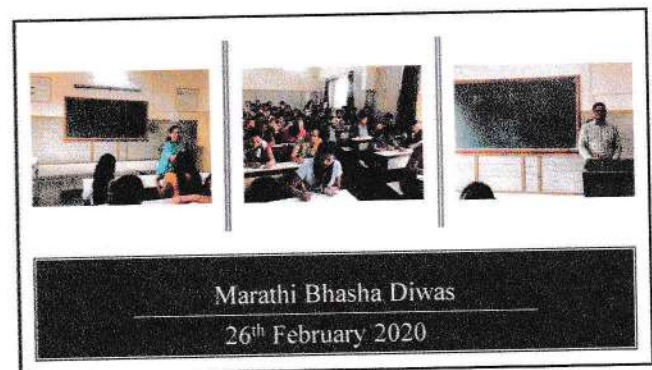
