

- 2. Students were enlightened with practical and technical knowledge of Solar plant.



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# Field Visit to the ancient Shiva temple at Ambernath 04th March 2020

Department of History of K B College, Thane had organised a field visit program on 4th March 2020 at 10.30 am to the ancient Shiva temple at Ambernath. The Shiv Mandir of Ambarnath is a historic 11th century Hindu temple, still in use, at Ambarnath near Mumbai, in Maharashtra, India. It is also known as the Ambreshwar Shiva Temple, and known locally as Puratana Shivalaya. It is situated on the bank of Vadavan (Waldhuni) river, 2 km away from Ambarnath railway station (East). The temple was built in AD beautifully carved in stone. It was probably built by Shilahara king Chhittaraja, it may also have been rebuilt by his son Mummuni.

Unusually, the sanctuary or garbhagriha is below ground, reached by some 20 steps down from the mandapa, and is open to the sky as the shikhara tower above stops abruptly at a little above the height of the mandapa, and was apparently never completed. It is in bhumija form. The mandapa has three porches. Much of the exterior figure carving is damaged, but some female and divine figures remain.

15 students of the department along with a faculty Dr. Deepak B Bansod visited and took the blessings of Lord Shiva. They appreciated the beauty and architectural design of the ancient temple.

The prime objective of the program was to inculcate the Ancient architecture along with socio-religious and patriotic feeling, research aptitude amongst students and motivate them to explore the new techniques and methods of presentation. Also to stir up love and respect for monuments and rich history of our nation in minds of students.



- To gain the knowledge about using the marketing strategy to capture large market area.























### Workshop on "Research Methodology

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





#### **Annual Report 2018-19**

In this academic year, Commerce & Accounts Department conducted various activities for the benefit of students. All these activities helped in overall development of our students. Following is the summary of all the activities conducted in the year 2018-19:

#### Add on course – Basics of Capital Market & Technical analysis (20<sup>th</sup> August 2018 to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018)

Commerce & Accounts Department, K. B. College of Arts & commerce for women, Thane, in collaboration with Machinfini conducted an Add on Course on the topic 'Basics of Capital Market & Technical analysis'. Students participated in good number and were very active and participative. The college faculties too were part of the informed audience. PowerPoint presentations were done on investment related factors, risks, avenues, recent malpractices, rights, duties and powers of regulatory bodies.

Outcome-The students became aware about basics of investment. They could understand the risk and return calculations. They got information regarding all regulatory bodies to be cautions and safe investors who knows his/her rights and powers.

### 3. Industrial Visit to Jawarharlal Nehru Port Trust, Uran (29th September 2018)
