**Outcome:** It helped students to develop the skills which are very much needed to face the challenges and explore the opportunities in the world of competition.

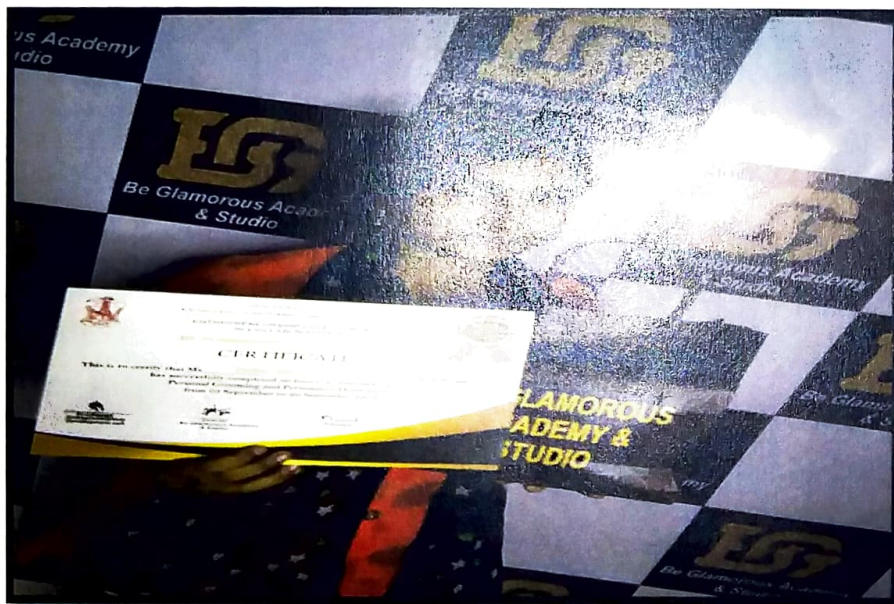
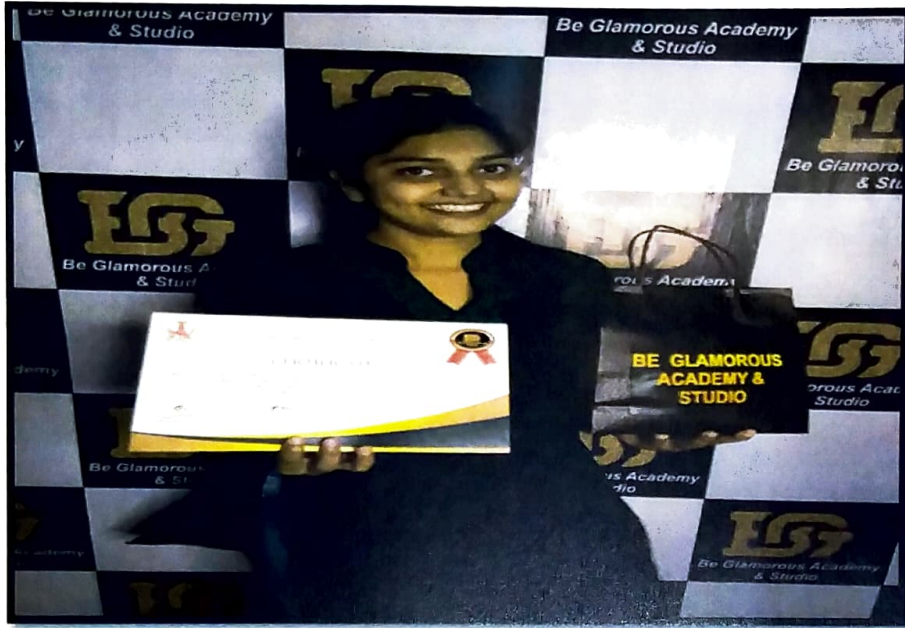

## Workshop on Manufacturing and Designing of Artificial Jewellery



It had one field visit where students were taken to Masjid Bunder and Crawford road where they can buy the raw material in bulk.

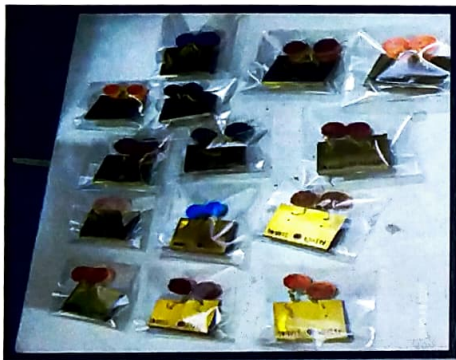
Student enjoyed the course very much. The cell conducted the exhibition of jewellery made by students.

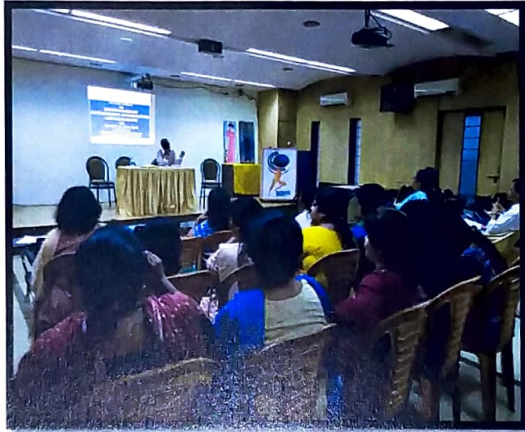
**Outcome:** While learning about entrepreneurship skills at a younger age, the students tend to incorporate new skills and start thinking like a leader.

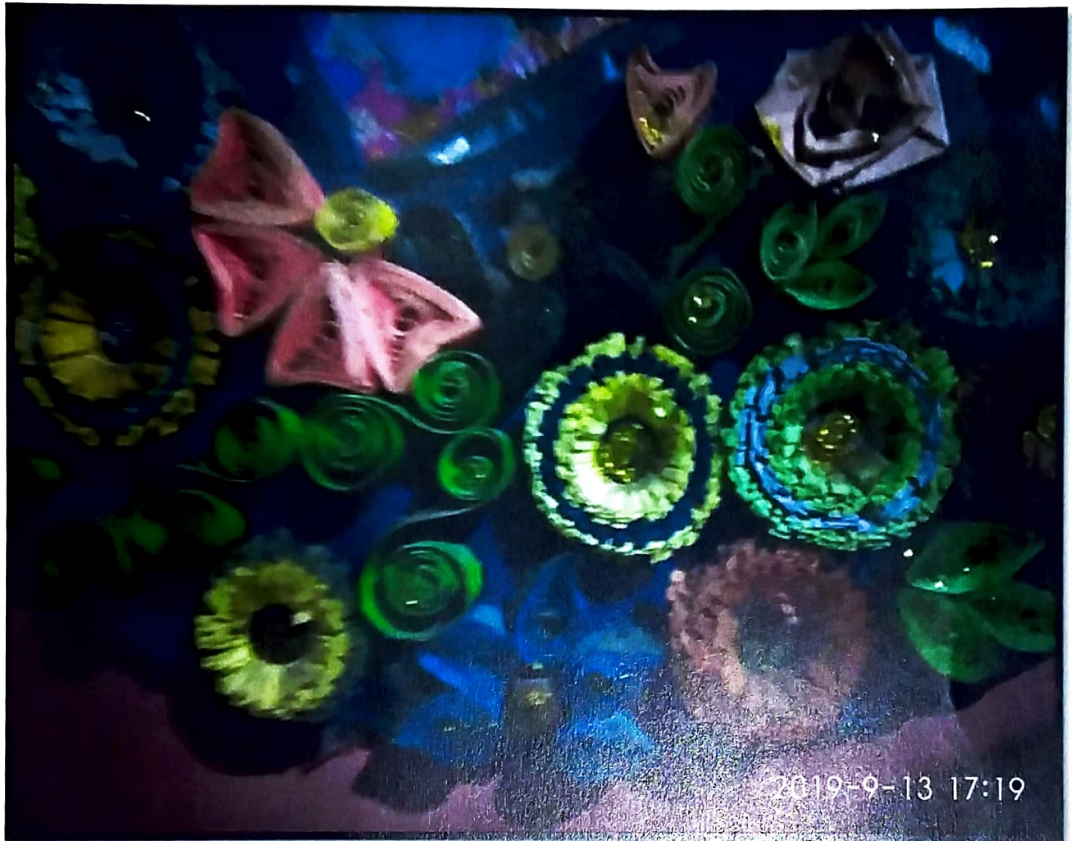


**Influence of 'Shrimad Bhagwad Geeta' on Developing Managerial Skills.**
