3. Students became self-reliant about preparation of project work.

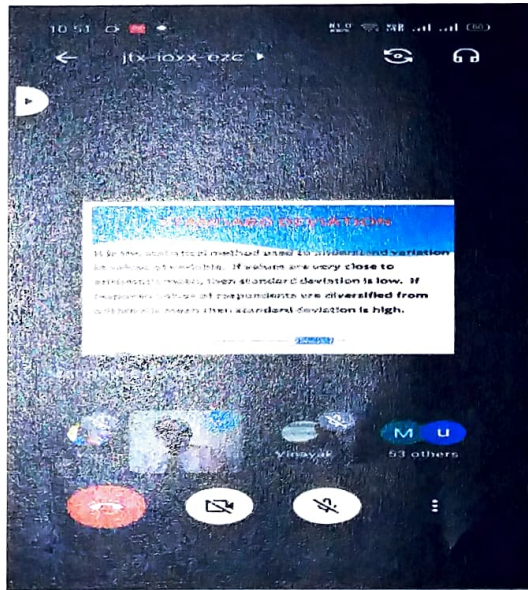
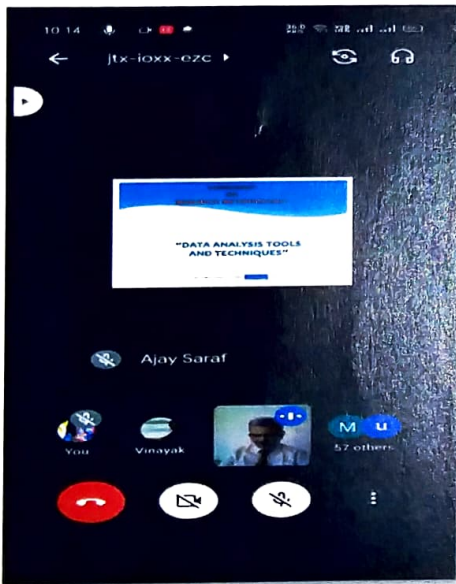
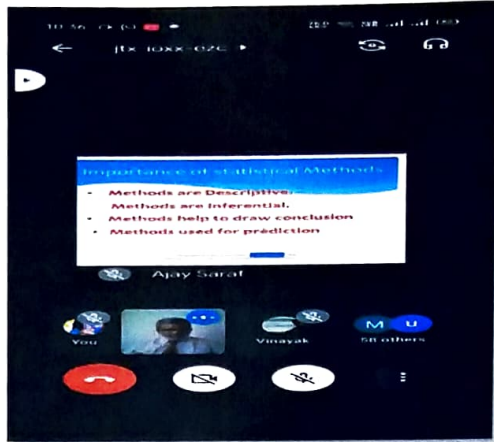
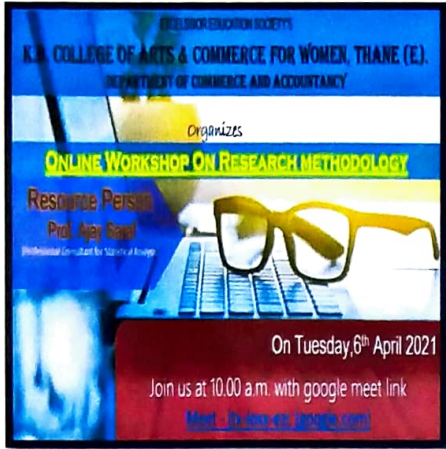

She also gave live demo of make up which was very interesting to see.

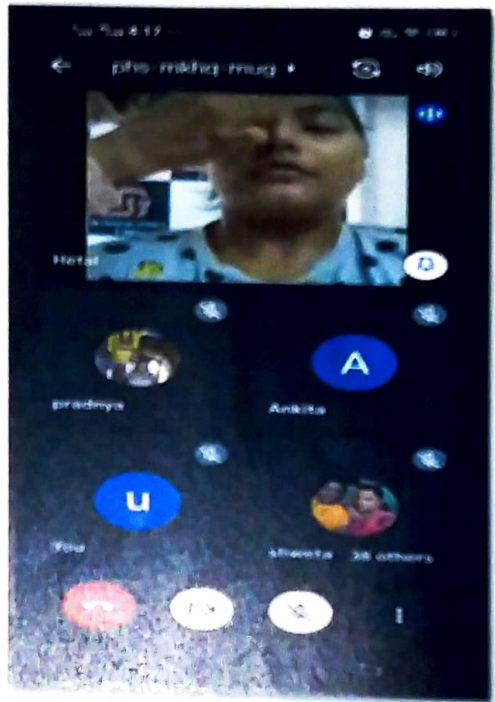
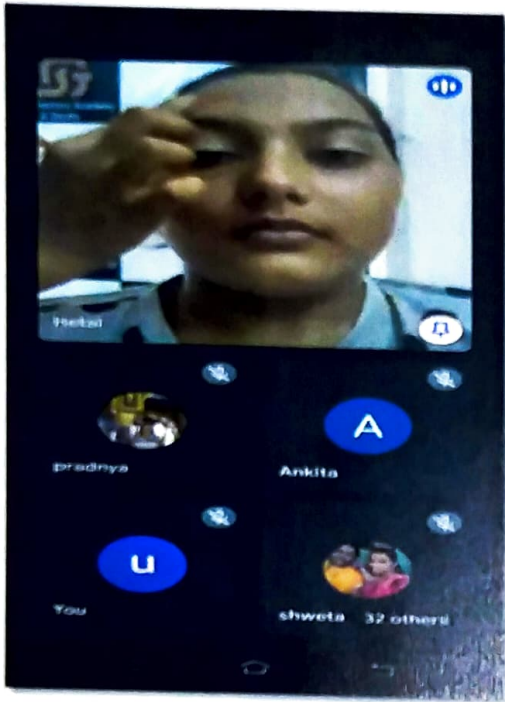
Overall session was very encouraging. Most of the students showed their interest in joining the classes of the same.
