Greetings from team Responsible Netism and the Maharashtra State Commission for Women.

In the current situation of the Pandemic, especially now in the times of the lock-down, internet usage has increased and so have cyber-crimes against girls and women. Most young girls and women are ignorant about cyber-crimes due to lack of awareness on online safety and reporting of crimes against them.

We strongly believe, empowering young girls and women in cyber space would not only reduce cyber threats but equip them to handle online distress. Education on responsible online behavior is a preventive intervention to empower netizens with strategies to make their digital experiences happier, fruitful and most importantly safer, thereby ensuring mental well-being in cyber space. **The Maharashtra State Commission for Women in collaboration with Responsible Netism is hosting webinars titled Digital Stree Shakti** specifically for young girls of your college studying in Junior and senior colleges.

Digital Stree Shakti is conceptualized by Responsible Netism the only non-profit committed towards cyber wellness and online safety within Maharashtra. 1. This webinar is conducted only for female students and professors of the college for duration of 90 minutes, followed by a Q and A.
2. This programme is supported by the Maharashtra State Commission for Women and is hence free of cost.
3. The webinar is conducted through a video conferencing portal like ZOOM, Google Meet, Microsoft team etc. It could be hosted by us or the college.
4. The mandatory condition is to have a minimum requirement of 100 participants in the webinar failing which the webinar may have to be cancelled or postponed due to lack of the required number of attendees.
5. We would circulate a Google Pre-test form prior to the workshop to gauge cyber safety knowledge levels of participants.
6. This would be followed by the registration process of the webinar
7. Post the workshop a feedback form would be circulated and collected by us.
8. The college is requested to create an in-house poster for circulation and registration prior to the workshop for registration.



9. The college is also requested to distribute e-certificates to participants post our approval for which the MSCW and Responsible Netism Logos's would be shared by us.
10. The webinar format is as follows, the webinar would be addressed by the Principal or Professor with a welcome note and an introduction of speakers (which would be shared by us) followed by the session by the speakers, it will end with the Q and A followed by the thanks giving from the college.
11. The medium of instruction would be Hindi, Marathi and English, whichever most suitable to the audience.
12. Attendees would be given e handout post the session.
