**Outcome:** Students determined and took an oath to respect flag and also create awareness among different masses of the society

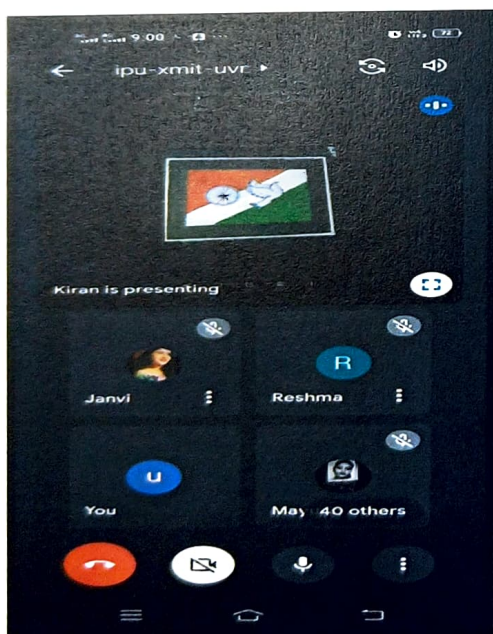
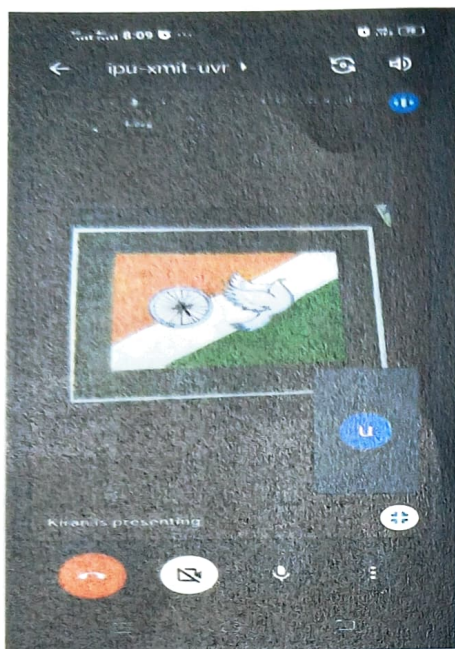

Every year, Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension Unit organizes a donation drive and donates the necessary items to needy students living in slums. For the academic year 2021-2022, the Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension Unit in association with NSS Unit organized a donation drive on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022.

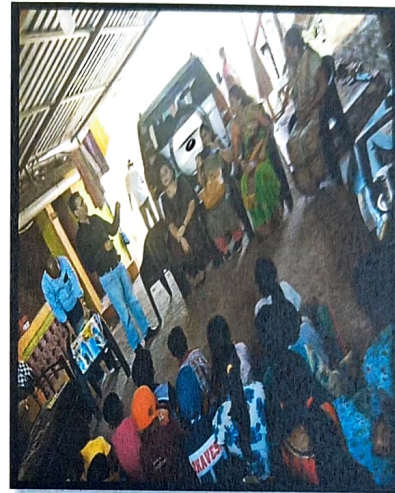
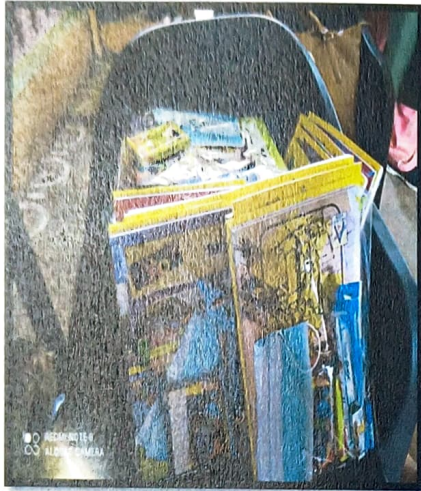

On 29<sup>th</sup> March 2022, the Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension Unit, conducted the most important activity in protecting the environment and creating awareness about the harmful effects of plastic on the environment, also how wearing a mask is important to protect against COVID-19, Pandemic. The students of DLLE made clothes bags, paper bags and also stitched masks. A total of 25 students participated in the activity to distribute masks, paper and cloths bags at nearby Kopri Village and Thane Station. The bags were distributed to vegetable vendors, fruit vendors and to the small shopkeepers selling general items to the customers. Before handover the bags, the students explained to them the importance of a Green environment and how day by day there is the degradation of the environment due to the massive use of plastic. The students also appealed the customers who found around the vendors not to use plastic. The main objective of the campaign was to make students and people aware of the bad effect of polythene bags on the environment, humans and animals. Total 56 paper and cloth bags were distributed along with masks. There was enthusiasm among the students. It seemed to be a very successful campaign.
