



This document constitutes a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between TNS India Foundation and K. B. College of Arts and Commerce, Thane.

#### Background

TNS India Foundation (TNSIF), a Section 25 Company engaged in the activities of charitable nature is conducting a "Youth Employability Program" for enhancement of employability and workplace skills for deserving youth.

1. In this connection, TNSIF intends to be associated and work closely with K. B. College of Arts and Commerce to conduct employability training and career counseling sessions for the final year college students. This will include activities through the year, till students are placed 10-12 months after their final year examinations. Features of the program are as follows:
2. 100-hour program including Personal Effectiveness (goal setting, interpersonal relationships), Personal Finance, Professional Effectiveness (how to choose right career option, how to apply for job, tools-CVs, cover letter- etc.), Business Communication (effective communication with co-workers and customers), Career Readiness (orienting students to jobs matching their skill sets and exposure to a career path) and Work Readiness (Professionalism, Work Ethics, Email Etiquettes, Workplace dynamics – etc.)
3. 60 hours of training will be delivered in class and 40 hours of mandatory training will be available to students on TechnoServe's proprietary online learning platform. The program also includes individual student counselling during the program, post training, pre-placement and also post placements.
4. There is no cost for students to attend the above mentioned training
5. Each training batch size will be a maximum of 60 students. Sessions of duration 2 hours each to be conducted 5 days/week. Trainings to be conducted for 2 or more batches in one day through one TechnoServe trainer
6. Counselling support is available on training days for providing career guidance to students who are enrolled in this program.
7. Students will be provided a certificate on successful completion of course with minimum attendance criteria of 90%.
8. Students will be further supported in job linkages and placements from the time of training completion till they are placed i.e. 6-10 months after their training is complete.
9. College is expected to support the successful training and placements of all students, should they take up this service with TechnoServe.

**For this purpose, TNSIF requires support of the college in the following areas:**

1. Facilitating discussions and engagement with the 2018 current third year degree students and 2017 graduates where feasible. This involves the following:
  - a. Assistance in batch scheduling with ongoing final year classes.
  - b. Support in allocating batches (of 55-60 students approximately) per trainer for optimum utilization of resources and training effectiveness.
2. Infrastructure support for the following:
  - a. Training facility (a training room where 60 students could be trained). Training methodology requires some space in the middle of the room for conducting student activities.
  - b. Space for the career counsellor/ trainer who would be available in college on days of training.
  - c. Availability of classroom to conduct refresher sessions before the pre placement begins in the months of Dec-Feb



- d. Projector and speakers on need basis which are required to conduct few video based sessions.
- e. Require college support to conduct a Parent engagement session in the college premises.
- f. Provide 100-200 students for training whom TechnoServe will screen.

Upon a request by TNSIF for this support, **K. B. College of Arts and Commerce** has agreed to support and provide the appropriate assistance to TNSIF, as mentioned below.

Based on the above, this MOU lays out immediate next steps to be taken by both parties.

**TNSIF agrees to -**

1. Conduct Orientation sessions to make students **aware about the program** and register their interest.
2. Engage with students and form batches based on selection criteria for conducting the training program.
3. Conduct the Employability Skills training program in College premises.
4. Provide career counselling support to students enrolled in this program.
5. Facilitate further linkages with vocational training partners and employers for interested students.
6. Bi weekly placement reports and monthly placement reports of students linked to job opportunities will be provided to the college once placement activities commence.
7. Helpline facility will be provided to the students to address their queries during training, post training and post placement.

**K B College of Arts and Commerce agrees to -**

1. Make classroom(s) available to train students in batches of 55-60, which should be ideal to cover 2 batches per day. If more students express interest for this period, we may create another batch after this batch. The classroom should be equipped with board and AV system when required.
2. Make table space available for career counseling.
3. Providing one contact point who could be approached for any support (student engagement) related to this program.
4. This MOU is neither a contract, nor is it legally binding in any way, nor does it commit any financial expenditure from or for either party.

7. The Second Part will provide training for 110 hours to every enrolled candidate and issue certificates on completion of training course.
8. The Second part will register the students sponsored by Citi bank on the basis of following documents supplied by the students – Aadhar Card, 12<sup>th</sup> Marksheet, Pan Card, 2 photographs.
9. The First Part will provide with necessary infrastructure like classroom, computers, Projectors, computer lab for training the students. It will also mobilize students, motivate them and convince the parents (if need arises).
10. The First Part will support the Second Part in completion of enrollment formalities before the start of the program.
11. The Second Part will provide interview opportunities to all eligible candidates for full time employment post completion of training.

2. Second Party grants to the First Party, its permission to conduct the above mentioned Course as value added / Certificate Course.






3. Second Party agrees that no revenues will be collected by the First Party from the participants without the consent of College management.

**1.0 INTRODUCTION :**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made between IQAC of institutions listed below and are referred to herein as "The Parties" to this MoU.

- 1.1 The Parties intend by this MoU to establish a mutually beneficial partnership.
- 1.2 This MoU will address the basic relationship, roles and responsibilities of the Parties but leaves for later agreement the more precise terms that will constitute the substance of the partnership

**2.0 PURPOSE :**

- 4.1.6 Conduct activities needed by the organizations together such as API Assessment/ Academic Audit/FDP/Workshops/Conferences/Cluster College/Placement Cell etc.;
- 4.1.7 To promote IQAC assessments in each other's colleges and to provide genuine inputs;
- 4.1.8 To create variety of types of feedback mechanisms to promote colleges to go for better governances.
- 4.1.9 To prepare an IQAC Calendar of events for better governance and to adhere to schedules.
- 4.1.10. Any other activity of common interest and that promotes quality in the working of the organization.

#### 4.2 The Parties agree to :

  - To promote quality-related research studies, consultancy and training Programmes, and
  - To develop strategies to collaborate with other stakeholders of higher education for quality evaluation, promotion and sustenance.
  - Sharing infrastructure to promote education.
  - To work on Institutional Social responsibilities.
  - Current issues – solving and awareness.

#### Some of the functions expected from IQAC by NAAC are :

- Development and application of quality benchmarks/parameters for various academic and administrative activities of the institution
- Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment conducive to quality education and faculty maturation to adopt the required knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process
- Arrangement for feedback response from students, parents and other stakeholders on quality-related institutional processes
- Dissemination of information on various quality parameters of higher education
- Organization of inter and intra institutional workshops, seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles and sharing best practices.
- Documentation of the various Programmes/activities leading to quality improvement through data management system.

- Acting as a nodal agency of the Institution for coordinating quality-related activities, including adoption and dissemination of best practices.
- Development and maintenance of institutional database through MIS for the purpose of maintaining /enhancing the institutional quality.

- Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) as per guidelines and parameters of NAAC, to be submitted to NAAC

1. Each Party pledges in good faith to go forward with this MoU and to further the goals and purposes of this MoU, subject to the terms and conditions of this MoU. The Parties shall attempt to resolve disputes through good faith discussions.
2. Either Party may withdraw at any time from this MoU by transmitting a signed writing to that effect to the other Party. This MoU and the partnership created thereby shall be considered terminated sixty (60) days from the date the non-withdrawing Party actually receives the notice of withdrawal from the withdrawing Party. In case of an abrupt withdrawal when the event is to start or is in process the party must cooperate to fulfill the event and make it successful.
3. The Parties agree that if withdraws at any time from this MoU previous student data submitted by will remain with the parties. If the data is to be used, it will be used with mention and would be communicated to the concerned party before use. Sensitive data cannot be used.
4. By mutual agreement, which may be either formal or informal, the Parties may modify the list of intended activities set and/or determine the practical manner by which the goals, purposes and activities of this MoU will be accomplished. However, any modification to any other written part of this MoU must be made in writing and signed by both Parties and their designees.
5. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed to authorize or permit any violation of any Government, State or local/UGC or University law imposed upon the Parties,
6. The parties will not compel each other that could lead to any legal hassle. Every party has right to share the information they feel worth sharing. It is no binding on the parties to share each and every information.
7. The issues with intellectual property right can be shared only with prior permission of the concerned party
