












- 5) Establish linkages with organizations for practical learning as well as improving English Conversation and communication skills for vernacular medium students.


Department presentations were followed by Activity / Committee Presentations (viz Student Council, DLLE, NSS, Placement Cell, PTA, WDC and Cultural)

The efforts made by all the above committees through various programs are much appreciated.


Remarks on the presentations made by the Committee Heads




