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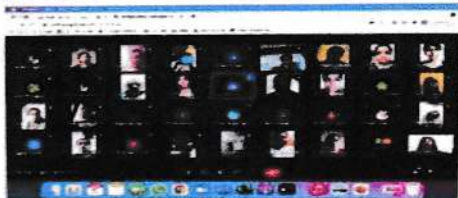

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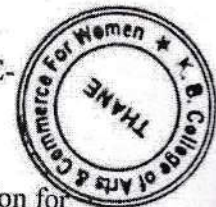
Extension Unit- Annual Report 2019-20

The activities for the year 2019-20 commenced with the enrollment process with Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension, University of Mumbai in July and August 2019. In all, 76 students enrolled for the extension programme and selected three projects i.e., SWS (Status of Women in Society), Career Planning and Annapurna. The first term training programme for the students was conducted in college on 29th August, 2019 by designated DLLE field coordinator Dr. Vinda Manjramkar. She gave a guidance lecture to students and answered all the students' queries satisfactorily. The students carried out survey work in October, November and December 2019. A variety of food stalls like Bhel, Idli, Juices, Tea, Poha, Manchurian, Pani Puri, etc were kept throughout the year under Annapurna Project. The Annapurna Project helped to inculcate entrepreneurship skill among the students.

The second term DLLE training was held on 20th Dec, 2019 at SICES Degree College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Jambhul Phata, Chikholi, Ambernath. The training was based on completion of project reports. The second term training session for the students by field coordinator Dr. Vinda Manjramkar was held on 4th Jan 2020 in the college. In this session, she explained the process of analysis of the data collected, report writing and documentation required for project. The Udaan festival was held on 31st Jan, 2020 at Shri Sidh Thakurnath College of Arts and Commerce, Ulhasnagar. Total 13 students and 2 faculty attended the festival. Twelve students participated in the street play based on Education System and one student took part in poster making competition. Then the festival was ended with the certificates distribution by DLLE Director Dr. Dilip Patil and was followed by DJ for the student. The students had a great learning experience at the annual DLLE festival. The assessment of the student projects was supposed to carry out in the month of March 2020, but due to Covid-19 pandemic, the evaluation was done on online mode, after a proper evaluation and screening, the reports were submitted to DLLE department. In all 75 students successfully completed the project.

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Extension Unit- Annual Report 2018-19

The year 2018-19 commenced with the zestful enrollment of students in Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension, University of Mumbai in July and August 2018. Total 66 students were enrolled for the extension programme. The SWS (Status of Women in Society) project was chosen by the students. The first term training programme was conducted by DLLE at VPM's B.N. Bandodkar College of Science, Thane on 4th August, 2018. The training was very helpful for the faculty and students as well. The first term training programme for the students was conducted in the college on 16th Oct 2018 by designated DLLE field coordinator Dr. Vinda Manjramkar. Madam gave a guidance lecture to the students and solved all their queries satisfactorily. The students carried out survey work in October, November and December 2018. Then on 11th December, 2018, a second term DLLE training was held at Seth Hirachand Mutha College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Adharwadi, Kolivali, Kalyan. The training was based on completion of project reports. Then the field coordinator Dr. Vinda Manjramkar, conducted the second term training session for the students on 13th Jan 2019 in the college itself. In this session, she explained the process of analysis of the data collected, report writing and documentation required for project. On 19th Feb, 2019 at Chandrabhan College, Powai, Udaan festival was held. Which was attended by 13 students and 3 faculty. 12 students participated in the street play based on different social issues such as child marriage; gender discrimination; female foeticides etc. and one student participated in the poster making competition. Then with the distribution of certificates by DLLE Director Dr. Dilip Patil, the festival was ended. The DJ was also arranged for the student. The student had a great learning experience at the annual DLLE festival. The assessment of the student projects was carried out in the month of March 2019 by the faculty and DLLE field coordinator. In all 60 students successfully completed the project. The final assessment of the projects by DLLE was held on 12th April 2019 at Ambedkar B.Ed. College, Vikhroli.


