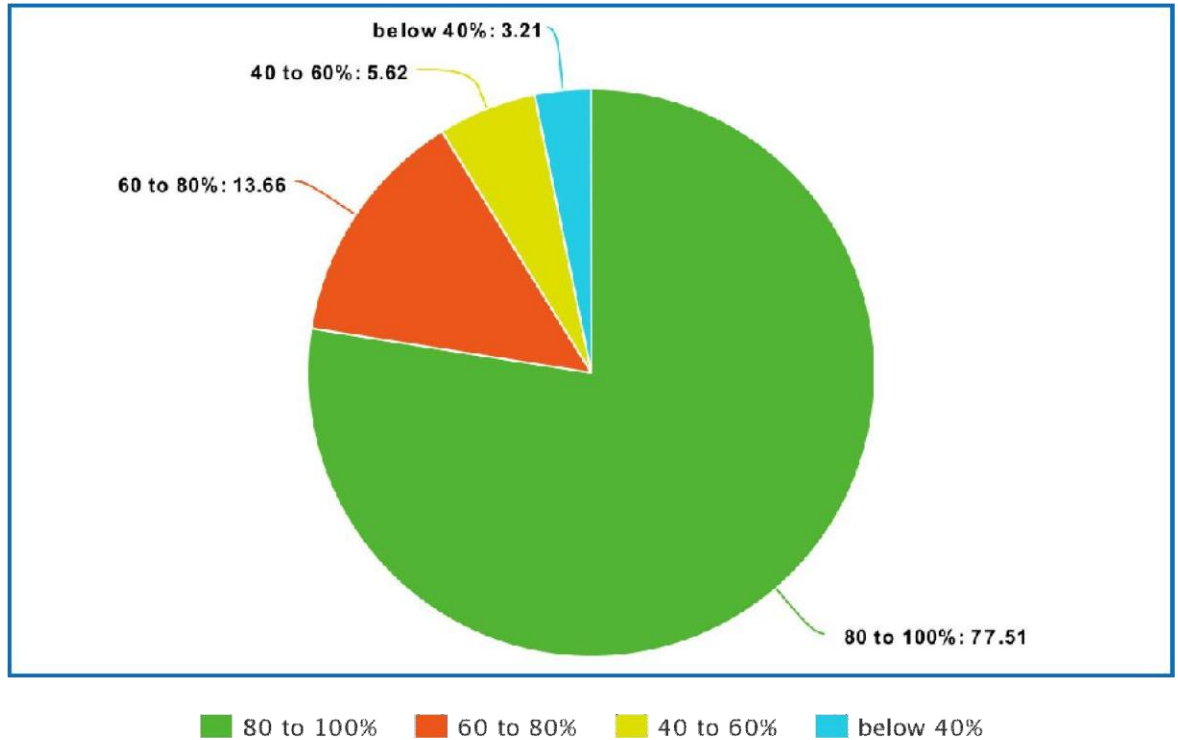
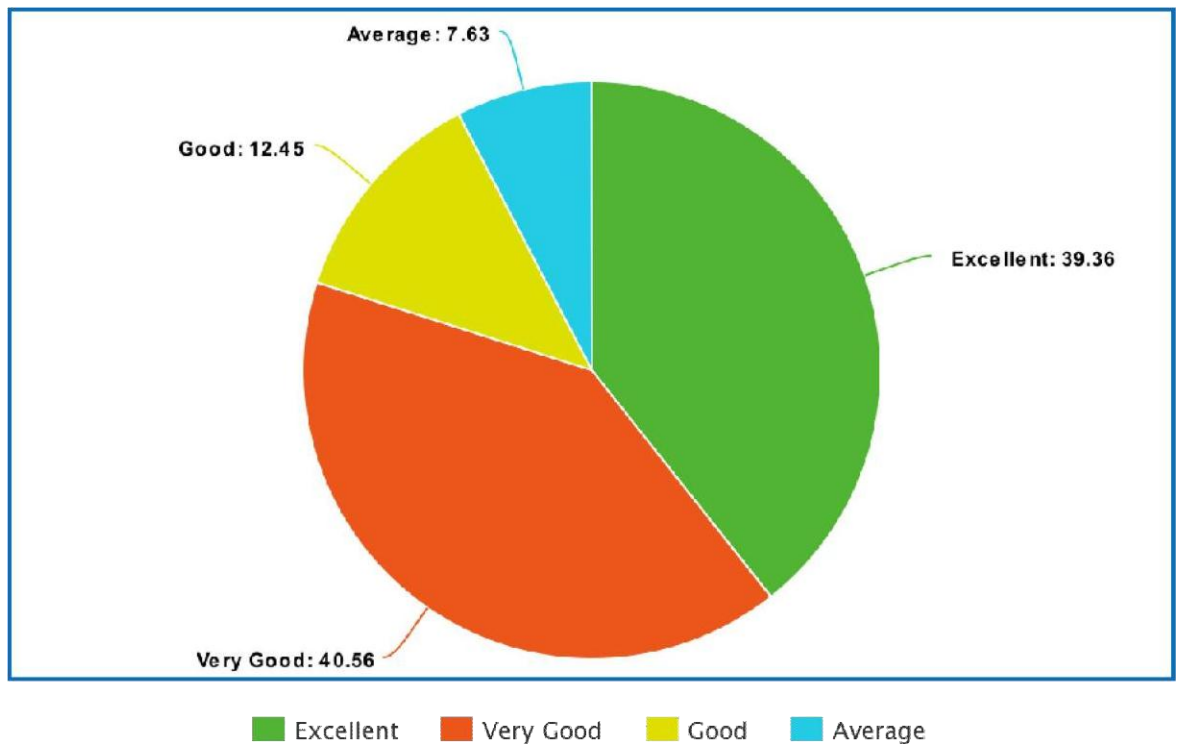

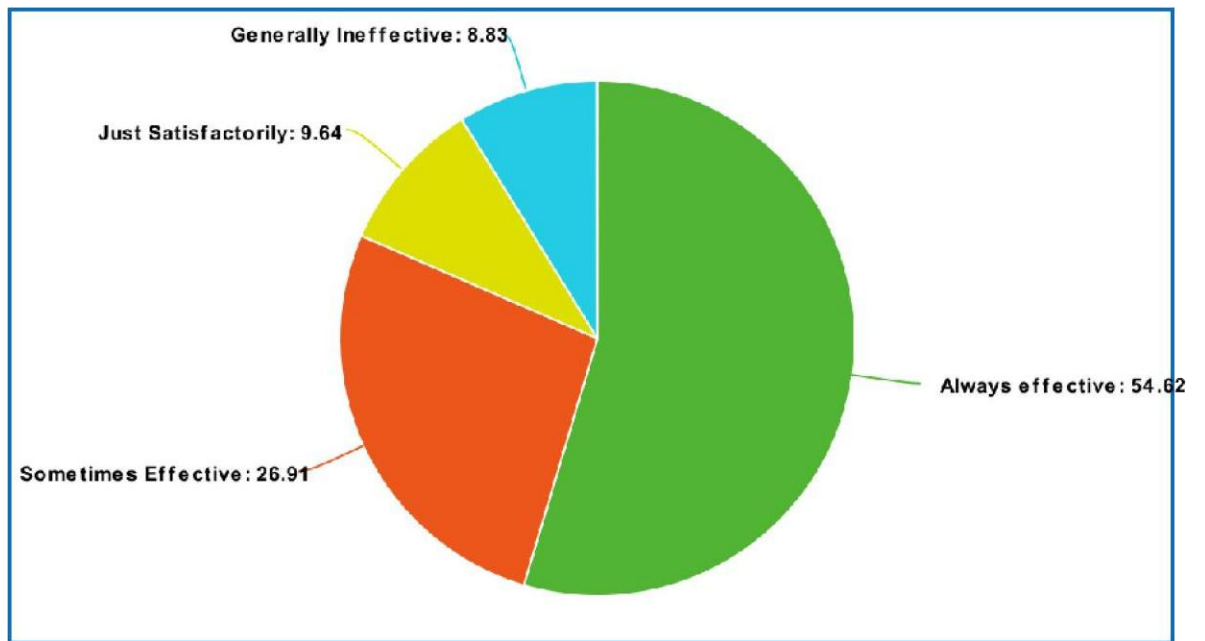
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



2. How well did the teacher prepare for the classes?

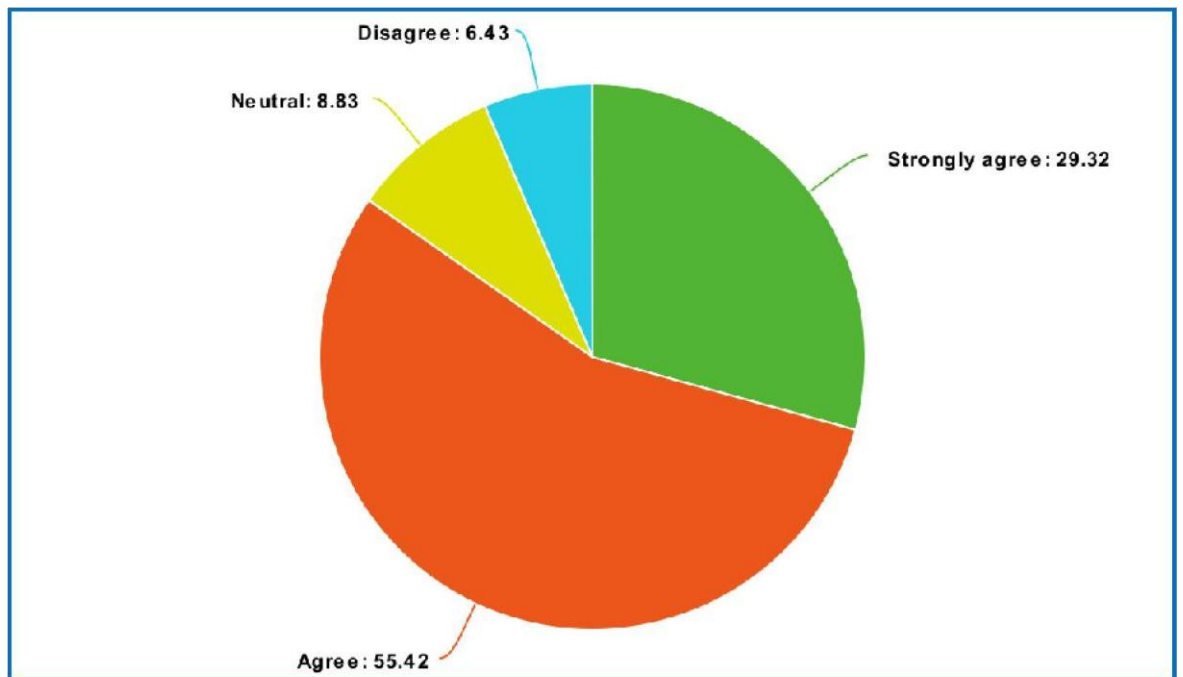

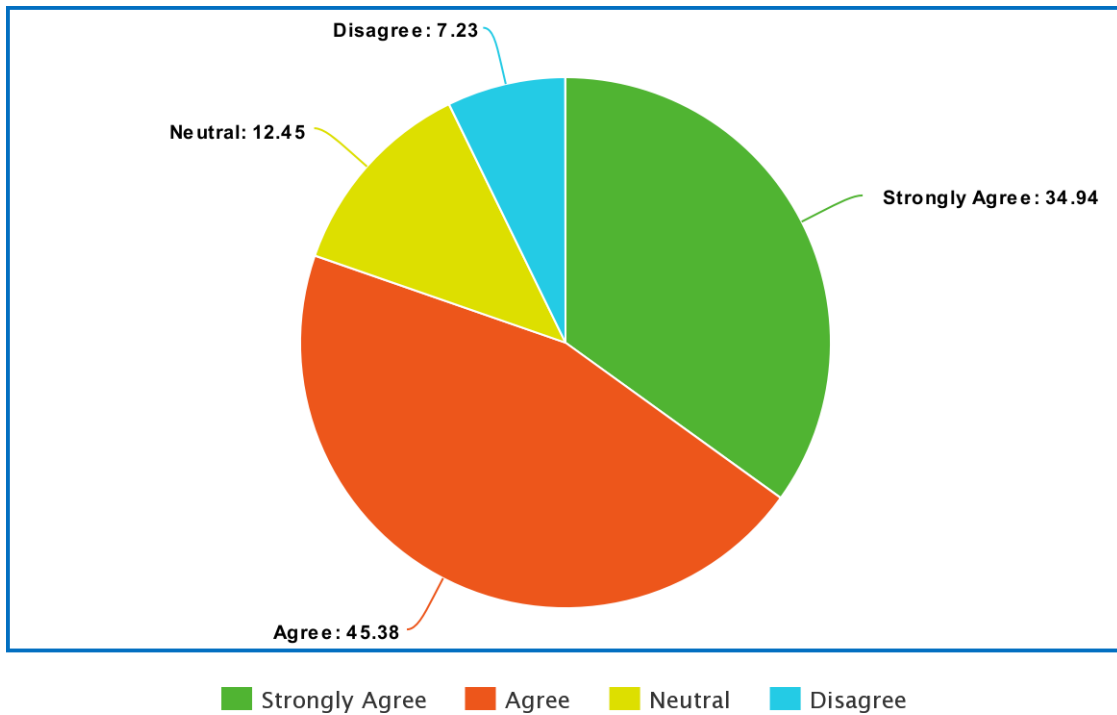

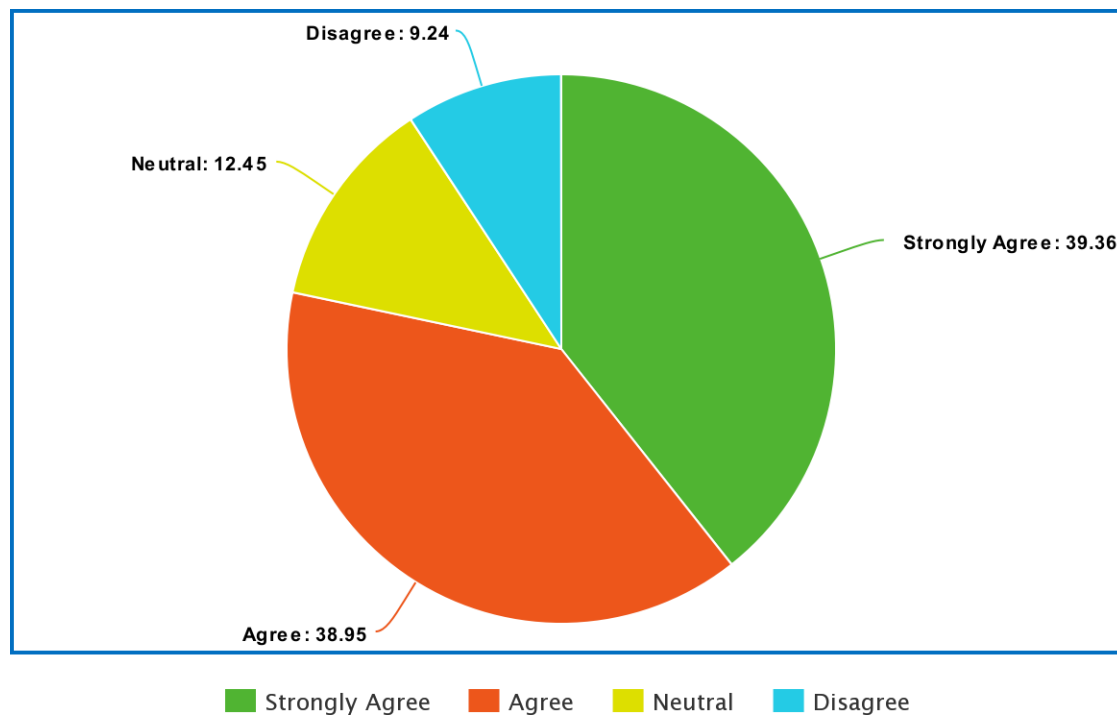

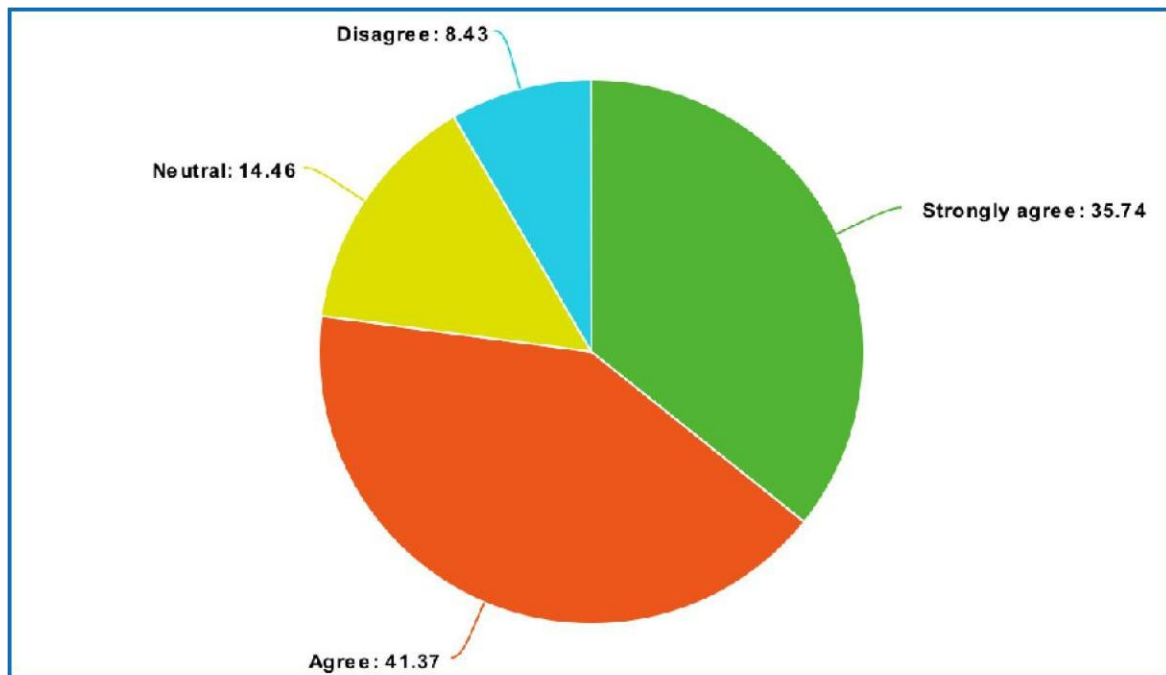

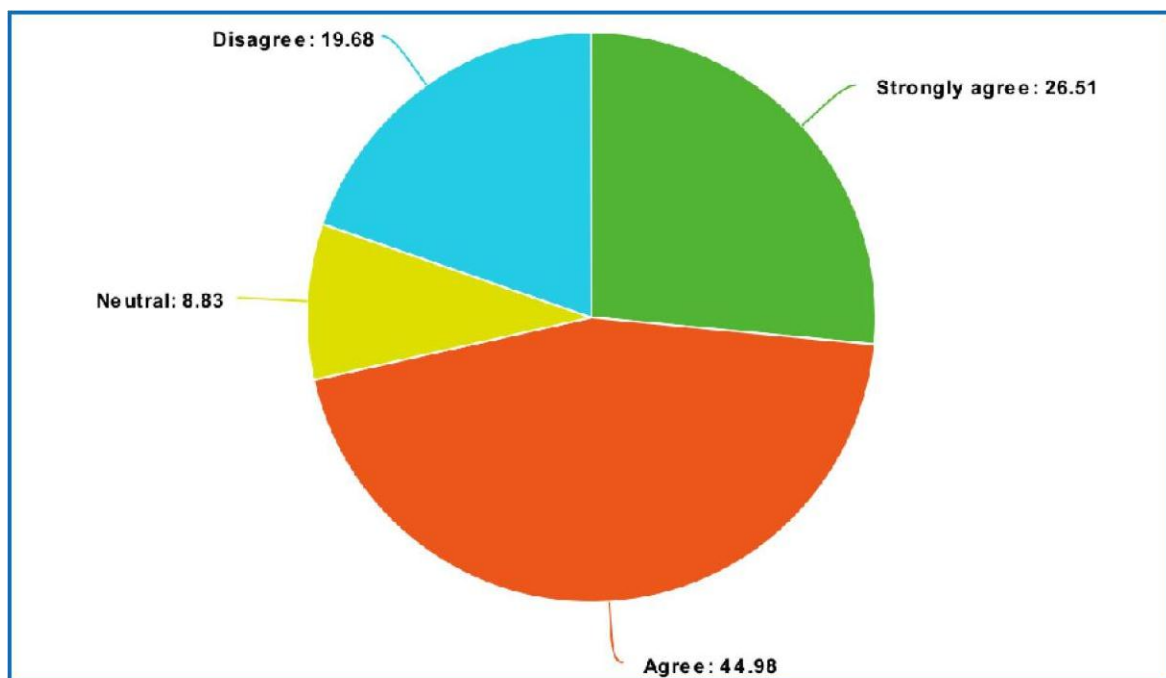

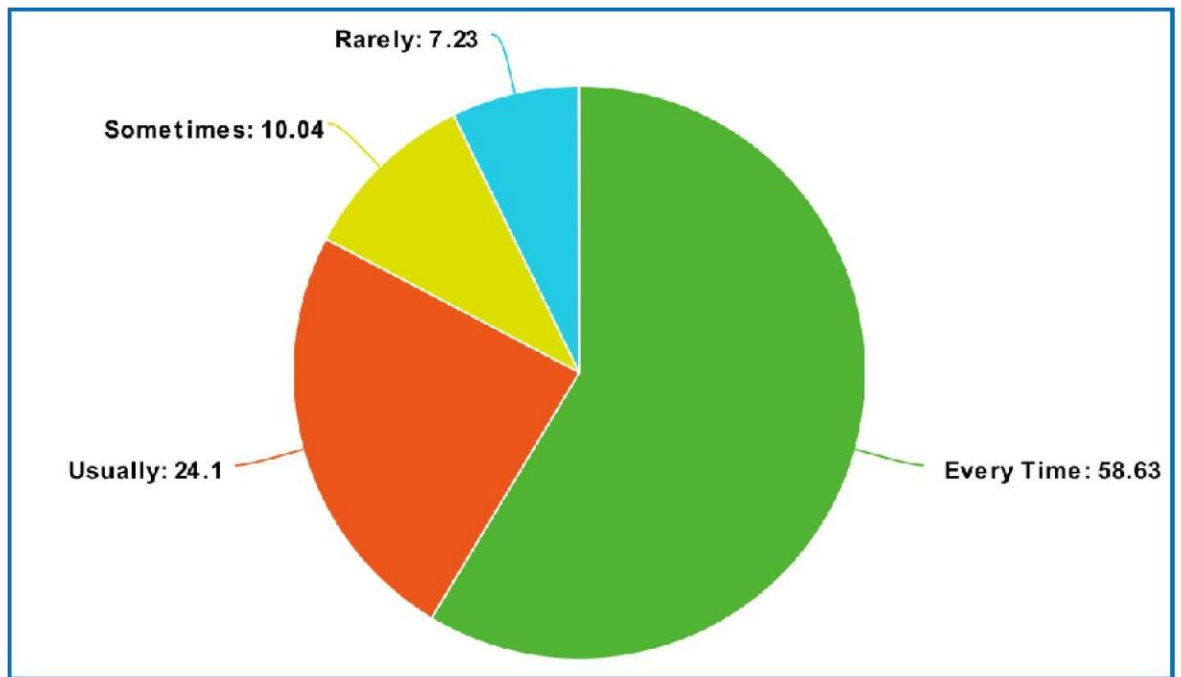

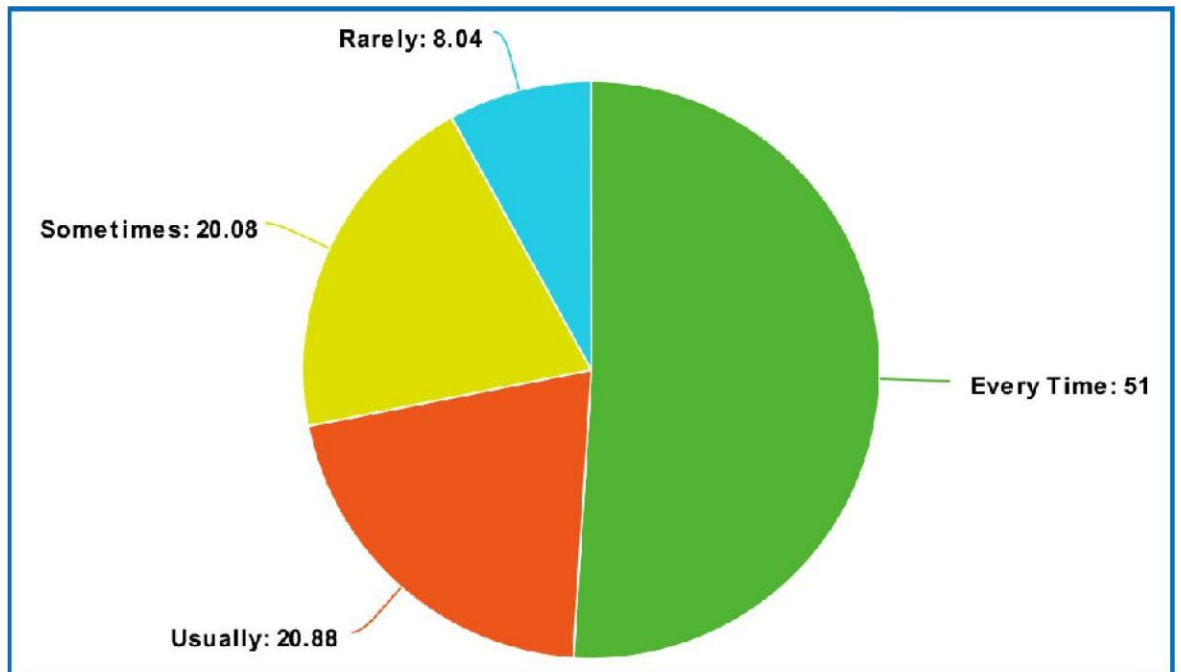

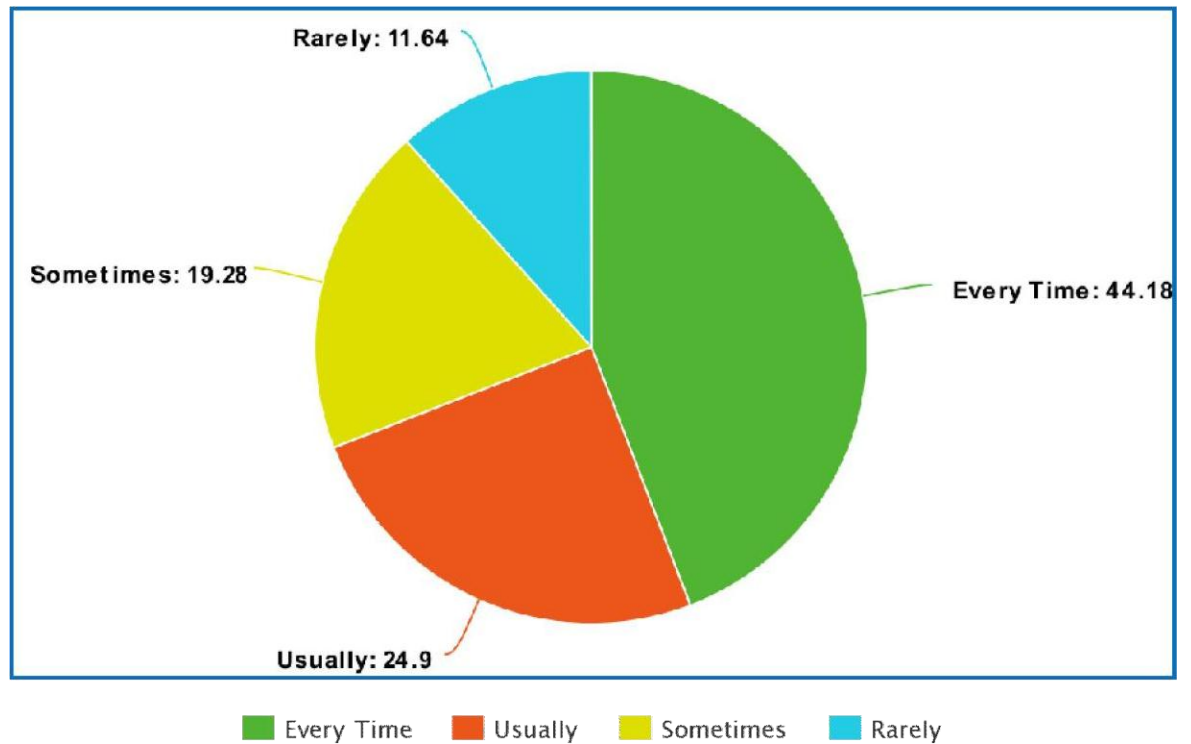

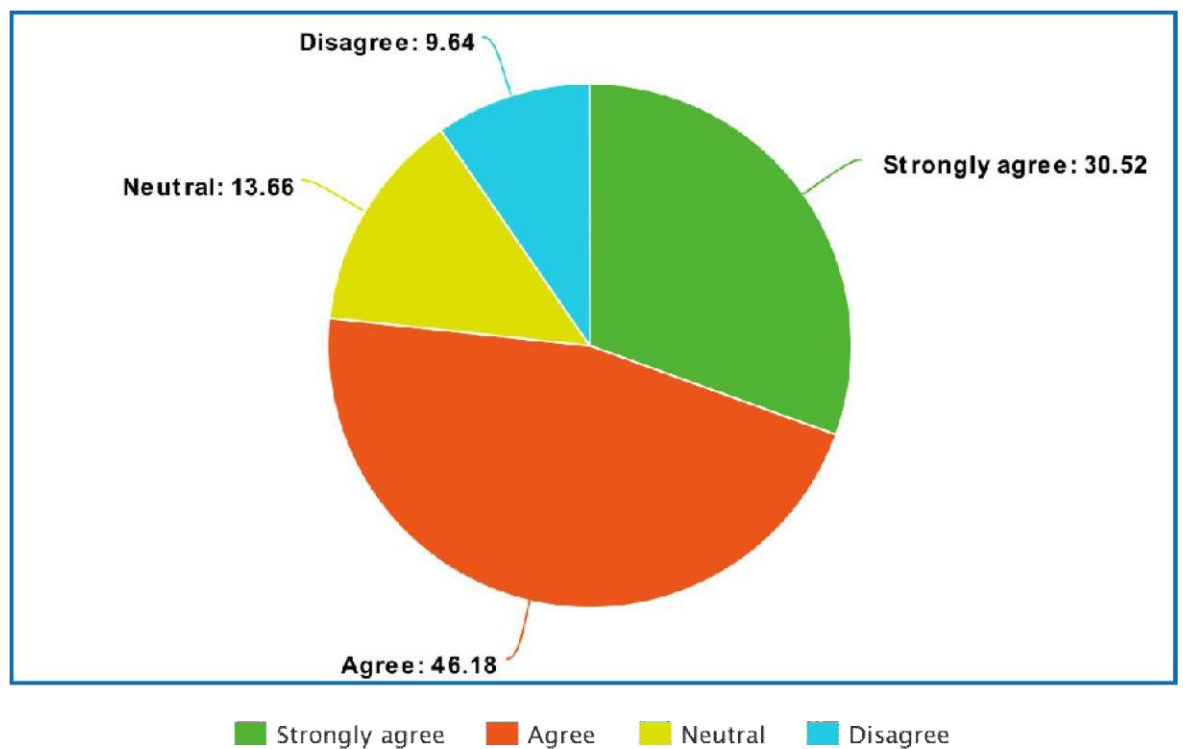

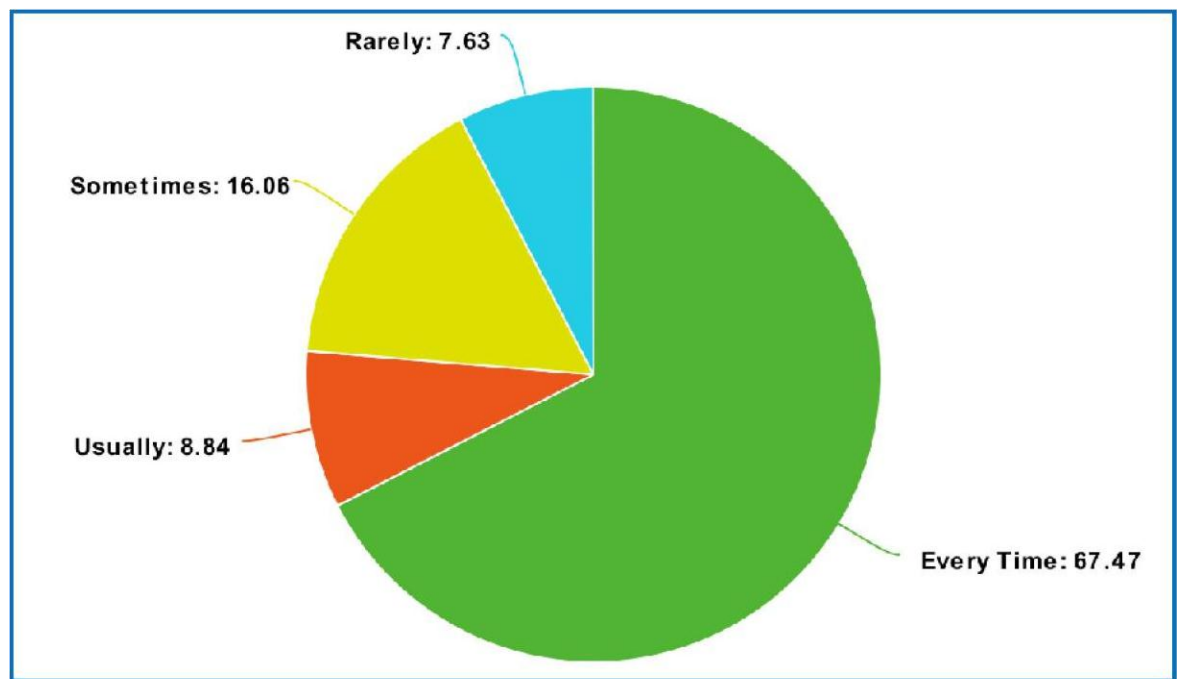

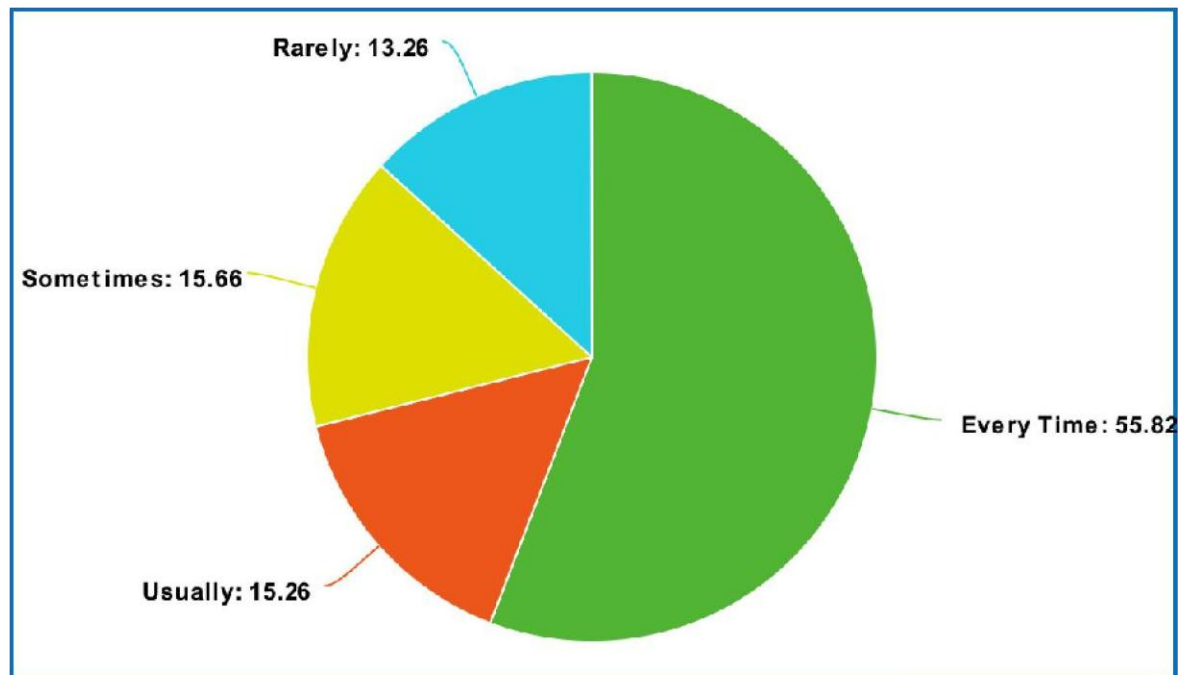

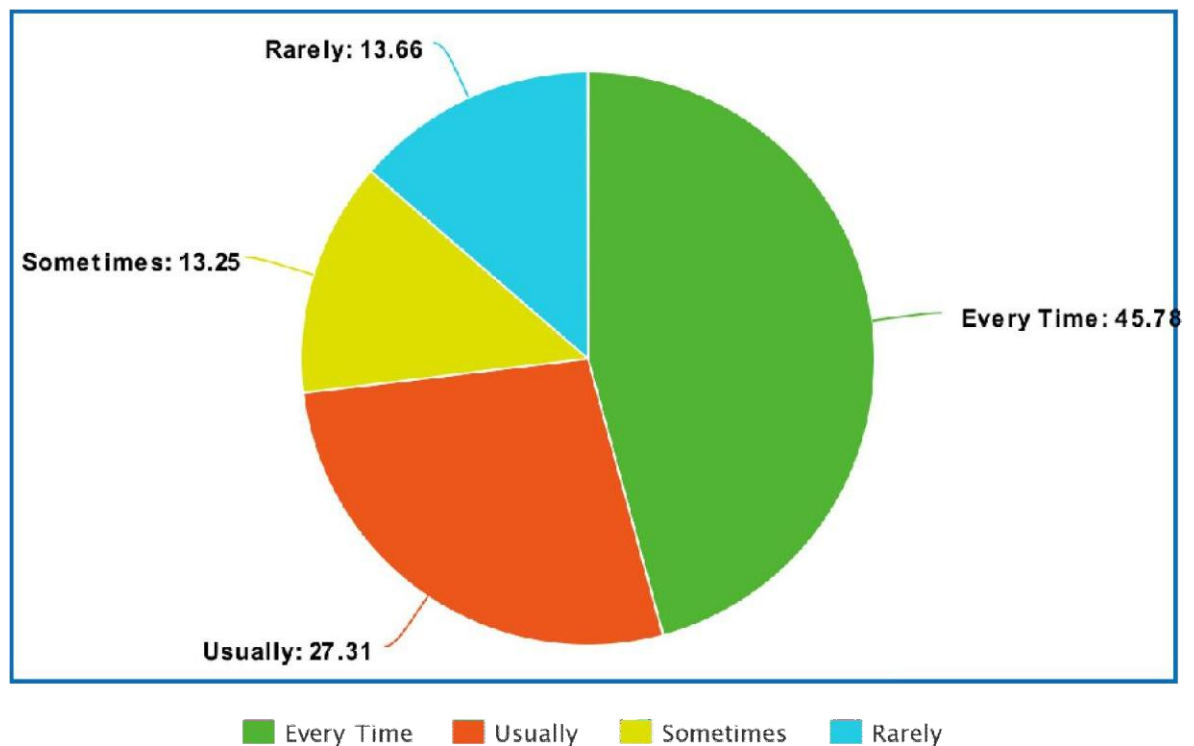

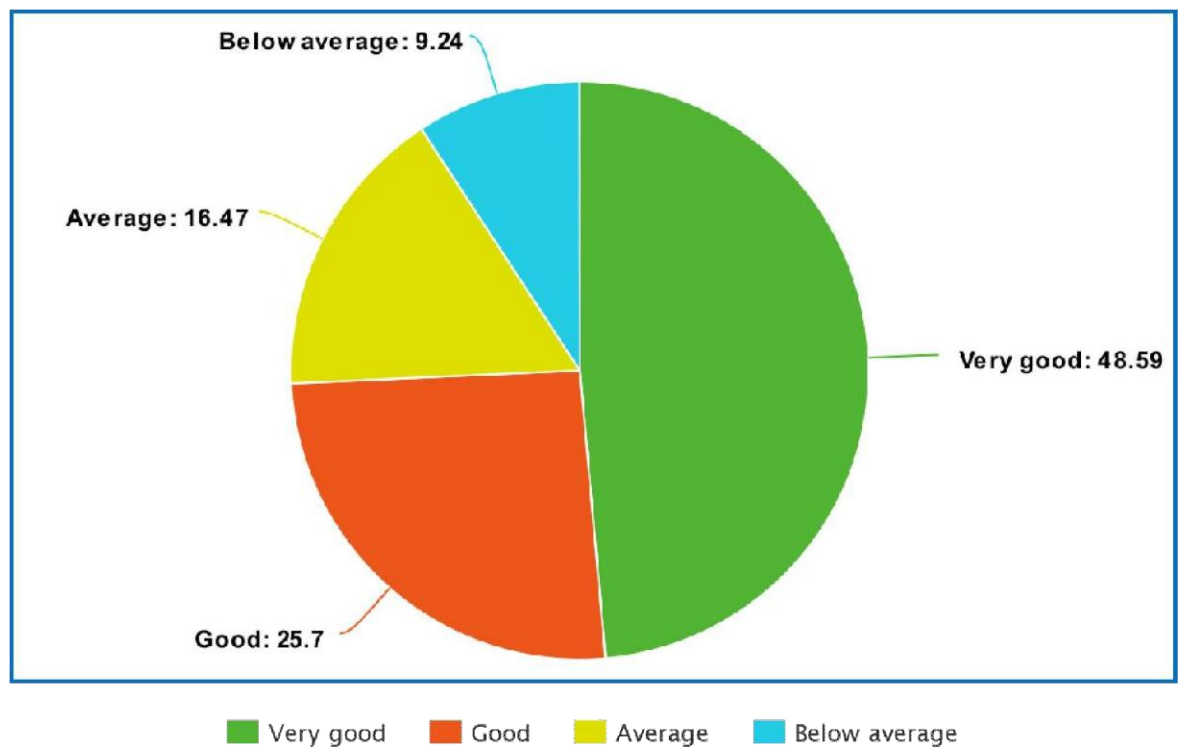
