
Objective: The prime objective of the program was to inculcate the social feeling, amongst students and motivate them to help society by planting saplings.

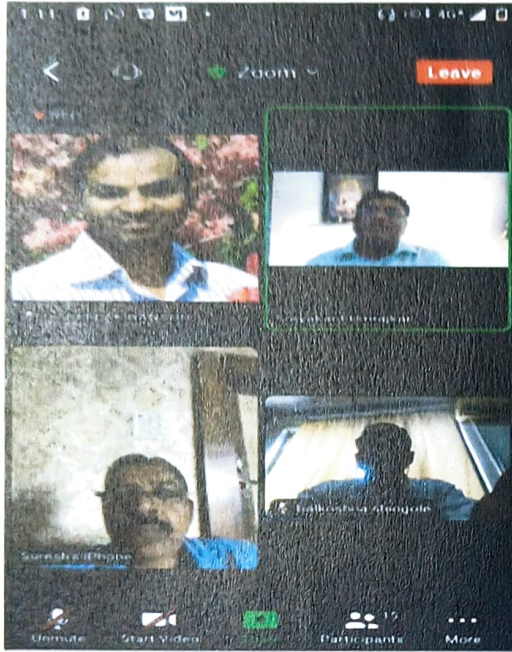

2. To create awareness about constitutional values among the students.

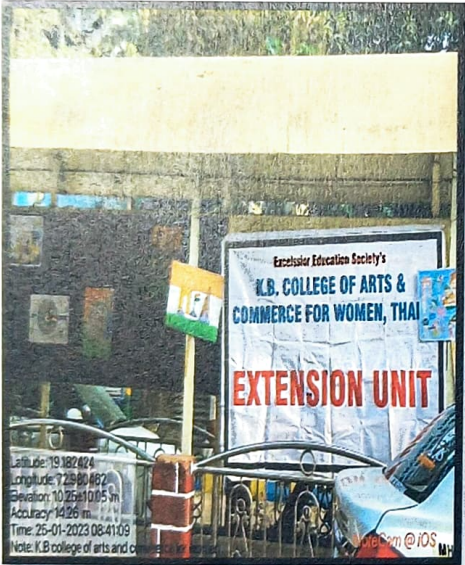
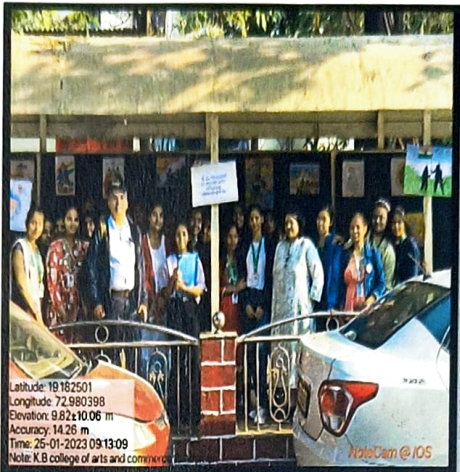

removal of Blind-faith,



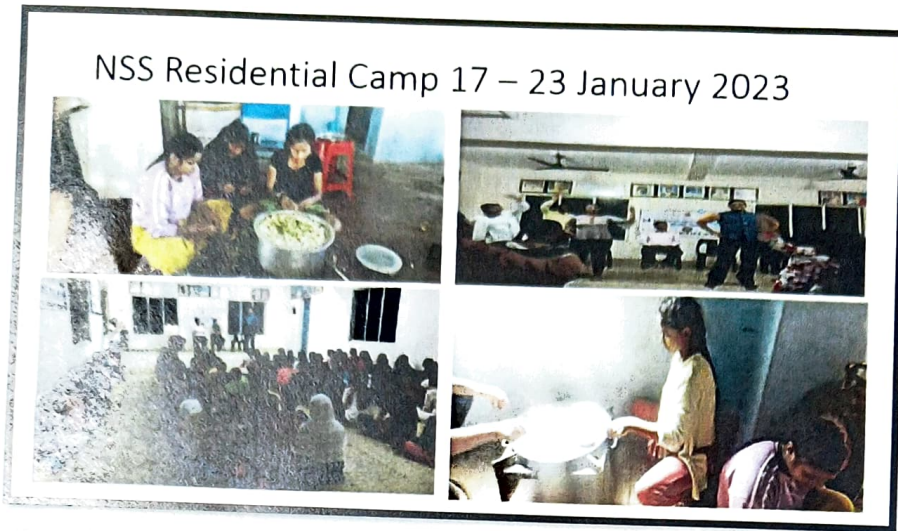

HEALTH CHECK-UP CAMP

19th January 2023

The Health club conducted ONE DAY HEALTH CHECK-UP CAMP in collaboration with Wavikar Eye Institute and Magicdil Help for students, staff (teaching as well as non-teaching) and local residents living in Kopri, Thane. Eye specialist(Sayli) and Physician(Mr.Nilesh Sonawane) with their team visited the campus on Saturday, 19th January 2023 and carried out a mass health check-up campaign. Around 200 students, teaching, non-teaching staff and localites benefitted out of this campaign. The Doctor after check-up prescribed necessary measures for follow up as per the deficiency found in students. The doctor's team was felicitated and welcomed by student incharge.

Doctor also explained to the students the regarding the general health awareness, change in lifestyle and its consequence etc. They recorded the height, weight, blood pressure and BMI for every participant. also provided service of sugar testing at a nominal fee of Rs 10 for those who wanted to get it done. The ophthalmologists' did a thorough eye check-up with modern equipment. They spoke to each participant individually and diagnosed the eye issues. It was recorded and was handed over to the participant for reference.

Students from all streams participated enthusiastically. More than 200 participants took advantage of this health camp.
