### Extension Unit- Annual Report 2023-2024

The enrollment process for the academic year 2023-2024 of Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension Unit was commenced in August, 2023 at college level. In all 75 students enrolled for the extension programme. Out of 9 projects prescribed the University of Mumbai, DLLE 4 projects chosen by the students namely SWS (Status of women in society), Career Planning (CP), Civic Services(CS) and Annapurna (APY) projects. The University of Mumbai was organized first term training programme in association with G.M.Momin college for the student manager and teachers. was organized on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2023. District coordinator of each zone elaborated all projects with detailed and guided how to conduct the project activities. They answered all the students and teachers queries satisfactorily.

The activities for the academic year 2023-2024 begun with tree plantation in association with GTT and Barklay and thereafter, DLLE unit carried out different activities such as session on Conservation of Mangroves, awareness campaign on Contaminated water and diseases, Respect to flag, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan and Distribution of Sanitary pad and E-waste collection at community level. Besides these, visit at Vatsalya trust, working for orphanage and old age people at Kanjurmarg, organized by DLLE to inculcate social values among the students. This year the most awaited and interesting activity of DLLE, University of Mumbai 'UDDAN' was organized at the B.N. Bandodkar College, Thane. The students of Extension unit participated in Poster making and creative writing competitions. It was a very good platform for the students to showcase their talent.

The extension project work completed end of February. This year, the University of Mumbai started the evaluation and screening process through Online. All annexures were submitted on DLLE portal, which was done in the month of April. As per instruction and circular received by DLLE, completed the major work of Annexures 9 and uploaded on DLLE portal in the month of April. Out of 75, total 56 students were successfully completed the project.

#### **REPORT OF NSS ACTIVITIES 2023-24**

## K B COLLEGE OF ARTS AND COMMERCE FOR WOMEN, THANE.

The National Service Scheme was started by Government of India, Ministry of Education and Culture, Govt. of India, in Collaboration with State Government in the year 1969 in 37 selected Universities. Mumbai University has been participating in the scheme right from its inception. At present the scheme is run by the ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports in Central Government and Department of Higher & Technical Education in State Government.

**K B College of Arts and Commerce for Women** have a shiny NSS unit which has been established with a fundamental objective of providing a platform for the interested students to contribute in social work during their free time. The Unit has 200 Volunteers enrolled under the guidance of Two Program Officers.

#### The report of the activities of the unit for the academic year 2023-24

#### 1. Enrolment drive and Orientation program:

Enrollment drive was conducted in the month of July and enrolled 200 volunteers for the year 2023-24. In order to orient the newcomers an orientation cum training program was organized on 17<sup>th</sup> July 2023.
