This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as "MOU") is entered into on this 01st day of March 2024.

BETWEEN

K.B. College of Arts and Commerce for women represented by its Principal (hereinafter referred as the "First Party", the institute which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED, 201, Cecil Court, Behind Taj Mahal Palace, Colaba, Mumbai, Maharashtra -400001 represented herein by CA Sumit Tajpuriya (hereinaster referred to as "Second Party", a company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as the "Parties" and individually as "Party").

WHEREAS

Crirst Party is one of the most reputed colleges in Mumbai K.B. College of Arts and Commerce for women The First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and cooperation between themselves will promote a more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

A) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.

B) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves, desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest.

C) GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED, the Second Party is engaged in the Business of financial consultancy and training and skill development and GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED, the Second Party is promoted by the Promoter named CA Sumit Tajpuriya, GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities

and shall share all the information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party, providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall co-operate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds, and documents (the "Definitive Documents") as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU ALONG WITH TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 2.1 The budding finance graduates from the Institutions could play a key role by acting as skilled finance professionals of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student and youth community to enhance their skills and knowledge and employability.
- 2.2 Training Methodology: Second Party would provide virtual training to students of First Party, with the presence of few offline sessions conducted in the college campus.
- 2.3 Hands on Training: The practical training and exposure provided to selected students through internship opportunities will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career.
- 2.4 Internships and Placements of Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and Placement of selected Students of the First Party into internships/jobs. Internships would be given to only those candidates who would be clearing the Eligibility Test (ET) which would be conducted post 45 days of training. For clearing the ET, a minimum of 60% score needs to be secured by the enrolled students.
- 2.5 Skill Development Programs Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging cloud-based technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.6 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licences of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.
- 2.7 It is agreed between the parties that Second Party would provide virtual training on 8 modules as listed on the website of second party for 45 days, with the presence of few offline sessions conducted in the college campus.



- 2.8 Students of First party should have Android mobile phones on which mobile application of Second Party would be downloaded from the app store, and once all formalities are completed, then a unique user ID and password would be created for each enrolled student.
- 2.9 Schedule to watch the training sessions would be shared on day one, and on WhatsApp daily follow up would be done by team of Second Party to make sure that students are watching the lectures as per the schedule. A report of students who are not sincere would be shared to the First Party by Second Party so that necessary follow ups can be done by the First Party.
- 2.10 A certificate would also be issued by Second Party to all the candidates of First Party based on the scores of the Eligibility Test (ET).
- 2.11 It is clearly agreed between First Party and Second Party that Free Training on Course (1) i.e., Financial Management would be provided by Second Party to first 100 enrolled sudents of First Party for a period of 45 days on 8 topics listed along with the attached brochure. Since Second Party intends to place the trained candidate's post their graduation, revenue of Second Party would be secured from such placements to be done, and hence Free Training is being provided.
- 2.12 It is clearly agreed between First Party and Second Party that Course (3) of Second Party which related to Financial Literacy is not Free and any student opting for the Financial Minor Course needs to pay the required fees mutually agreed between the first & the second party. Since in the Finance Minor Course of Second Party, the intent of Second Party is just to inculcate the sense of "How to Manage the earned money" and no employment opportunities can be provided in the second course, hence the same would be chargeable for anyone opting for the same.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, /estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or licence in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to knowhow, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid till 1 academic year from the date of signing until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED the Second Party, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.



CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under the MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorised to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party, Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.


