Department of History

Department of English

<u>Department of</u> **Mathematics, Statistics & Computers**

The academic year 2023-24 commenced with an introductory orientation lecture for all FYB.Com students. The department conducted following activities so as to give a rich learning experience to the students.

Bridge Course: Majority of the students of FYB.Com do not choose Mathematics at the junior college level. Due to this reason, a bridge course in Mathematics was conducted to cover the gap and remove fear of the subject. The course was conducted in hybrid form for 10 hours from 2nd August 2023 to 22nd August 2023. 77 students registered for the course. The 10 hours programme covered basics of the subject and stressed on problem solving sessions.

Along with the bridge course, regular lectures, practice class tests, assignments and revision lectures helped the students in preparing for the semester-end examinations.

National Mathematics Day Celebration: National Mathematics Day is celebrated on December 22 every year in honour of the great Indian Mathematician Srinivas Ramanujan. To celebrate the occasion, department encouraged FYBCom students to write articles on 22nd December 2023. Students were invited to write articles on great mathematicians and Applications of mathematics. The activity received a good response. 44students wrote articles based on the theme.

Department Project: The department undertook a project on 'Awareness of NEP among XII and First year students' in the month of February 2024. Four students participated in the project which was based on primary data collection. Students had a first-hand experience of collection, presentation and analysis of data. These 04 students presented the same data at Intercollegiate Competition on 'Data Speaks' organized by NKTT college on 8th February 2024. The project was a great learning experience for the four participants.

Video Show on 'Interest and Annuity': To demonstrate the concepts of Interest, difference between simple and compound interest as well as Annuity with animated videos, a video show on 'Interest and Annuity' was organized on 29th February 2024. Animated videos and stories with narrations based on Simple interest, Compound interest, power of Compound interest and Annuity, gave clarity to the students on the concepts along with stressing the importance of age of investor and period of investment. Besides, explanation given by the faculty helped to convey the message of early investments leading to good returns to the young investors. The faculty also demonstrated importance of period in loan EMI calculations.

In all 76 students from First Year B.Com attended the video show programme. Students found the videos very useful in understanding the concepts learnt in classroom teaching. The activities conducted by the department helped in enhancing the learning experience of students.

Department of Bachelor of Science in Information Technology

The Department of Bachelor of Science in Information Technology has conducted varieties of activities for the students to enhance their coding and logic development skills in the field of software development. Awareness about the Job opportunities and requirements in IT industry and the significance of communications skills. The following are the summary of all activities conducted in the year 2023-24.

The BSc. IT department conducted Workshop on Data Science for the students to help them to explore practical examples, techniques, and real world case studies to demonstrate the diverse applications of data science in various domains empowering participants to leverage data-driven insights for decision-making and problem solving and then we conducted a Seminar on Software Testing the main objective of the seminar was basically to ensure that the students should have a clear understanding of software testing in industry. As global certifications was an importance seminar but before going for global certification students need to have good command on the programming languages and one of the leading languages was JAVA Programming so we conducted the Seminar on Training (Add-On-Course) on Advanced Java Programming the aim of this add-on-course was to impart the basic programming knowledge on Java to the participants who do not have enough knowledge on programming and the application. The entire course was designed and divided into different topics as per the industry requirements. The total participants were 65. The objective of the Add On Course was achieved after receiving the certificates and positive response from the participants and this motivated us to organize more such programmes in future which would benefit the students to a great extent. And last Seminar was on Cloud **Internship Program** the internship program was very beneficial for the students. It helps them to understand the importance of cloud computing and its recent trends, services of cloud and its models. It also helped the students to learn about the various types of cloud services, live cloud computing projects and its behavior. The total participants were 50.

Students were given theoretical knowledge of stock market through online training programme organised by BSE. Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension Unit

Library

The college library plays a vital role as a hub of academic and intellectual development, offering a rich and diverse collection of resources, including books, periodicals, magazines, newspapers, maps, globes, compact discs, and project reports. These resources are thoughtfully curated to meet the varied needs of students and faculty, fostering an environment of learning and research. To complement its extensive collection, the library provides essential services such as book circulation, reference assistance, notifications about new arrivals, and the Book Bank facility, which specifically supports underprivileged students by providing them with textbooks.

This year, the library applied for the **Book Bank Scheme** under the Department of Student Development, University of Mumbai, to benefit reserved category students. Through this initiative, the library received a grant that was utilized to purchase textbooks for commerce students, which were then issued to eligible beneficiaries. Additionally, the library made significant investments to improve its academic resources, including subscriptions to periodicals that ensure access to high-quality content for students and faculty.

In its commitment to staying digitally relevant, the library subscribed to the N-LIST Digital Library Package, which provides access to over 1,50,000 eBooks and 6,000 eJournals as part of the e-ShodhSindhu consortium by INFLIBNET (UGC). This subscription was secured at an annual cost and has greatly enhanced the digital learning opportunities for users. The library also invested in the annual maintenance and upgrading of its library software through Biyani Technologies to ensure efficient and seamless operations. Furthermore, the introduction of digital membership with the National Digital Library (NDL) has further expanded access to a wide array of e-resources, empowering students and faculty with more learning tools.

In addition to its regular activities, the library, in collaboration with the Department of English, organized an intra-collegiate essay writing competition on the topic "My Ideal Teacher." The event saw enthusiastic participation from around 30 students from both the Arts and Commerce streams, who took this opportunity to express their heartfelt gratitude toward the teaching fraternity.

Looking forward, the library is dedicated to expanding its collection, further enhancing its digital infrastructure, and increasing awareness and usage of its e-resources through training sessions and workshops. The Library and Library Committee extend their sincere gratitude to the management, staff, and students for their unwavering support and encouragement.
